

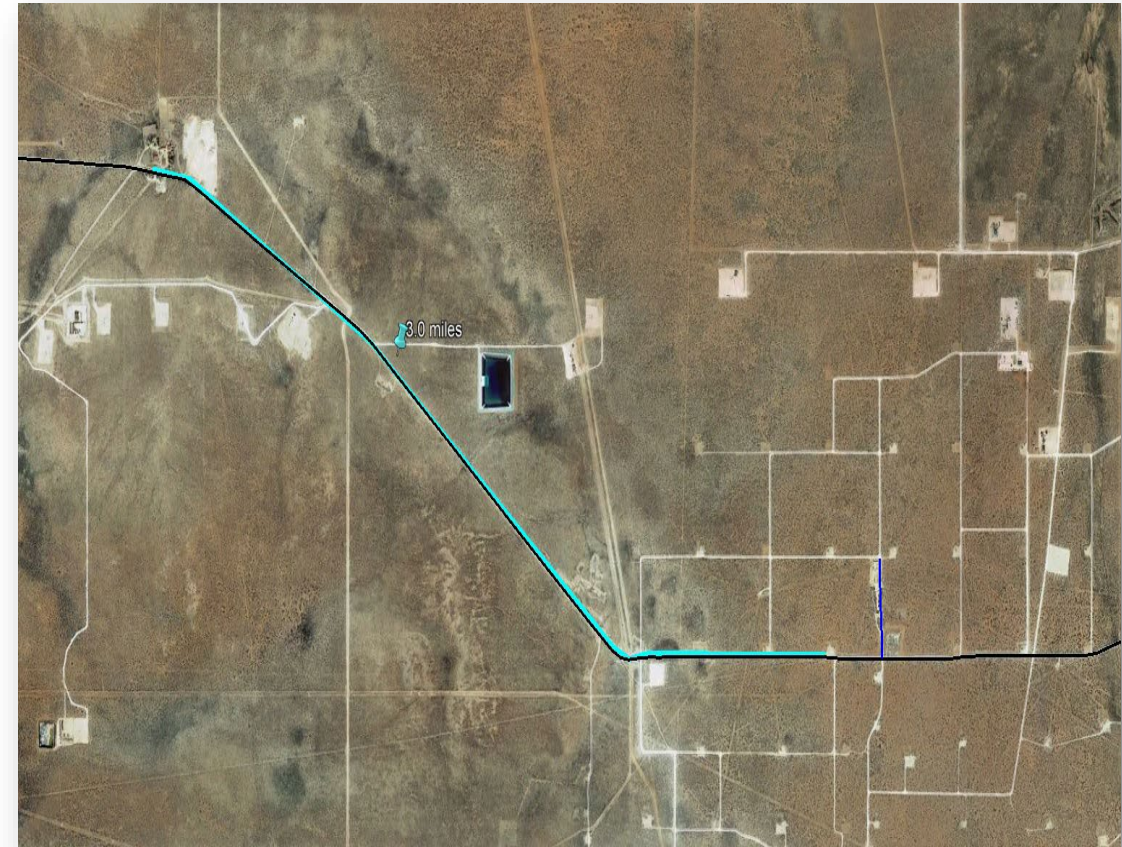

WHEREAS, roadways play a critical role in the emergency response, quality of life, and economic vitality for citizens of Lea County; *and*

WHEREAS, Battle Axe Road is a roadway vital to the Lea County due to the heavy commercial vehicles that use the roadway regularly; *and*

WHEREAS, Lea County requested a quote for the overlay of a portion of Battle Axe Road to extend its life and prevent damages consistent with chip seal roadways; *and*

WHEREAS, Lea County plans to utilize Lea County funds to complete the project; *and*

WHEREAS, Constructors Inc. submitted the bid to Cooperative Educational Services (CES) for the proposed work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that CES task order with Constructors Inc. to widen and overlay 3.0 miles of Battle Axe Road is hereby approved.

Any alterations or deviations from the above specifications involving extra cost will be executed only upon written order, and will become an extra charge over and above the proposed amount above. If payment is not received within 30 days from date of invoice, interest will be charged at 1 1/2% per month or fraction of a month on the unpaid balance plus incidental collection costs, including attorney fees. (As allowed by New Mexico Statute N.M.S.A. 1978, Section 57-28-5). This proposal also serves as acknowledgment of Constructors' request for the location of underground facilities. The property owner and/or the General contractor is responsible for the location of such facilities on private property. If either party commences legal action to enforce its rights pursuant to this agreement, the prevailing party in the legal action shall be entitled to recover its reasonable attorney's fees and costs of litigation relating to the legal action, as determined by a court of competent jurisdiction.

All material is guaranteed to be as specified. All work is to be completed in a workman-like manner according to standard practices. Any alteration or deviation from above specifications involving extra costs will be executed only upon written orders, and will become an extra charge over and above the estimate. All agreements contingent upon strikes, accidents or delays beyond our control. Owner to carry fire, tornado and other necessary insurance.
