





LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

WHEREAS, Mr. Salina applied for a vacation of said alleys and roadways on March 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Lea County Board of County Commissioners convened a Freeholder's Committee on April 14th, 2022, and

WHEREAS, the utility service companies serving the subdivision do not have objections to the vacation of the proposed right of ways; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Freeholders Committee recommends to deny the proposed vacation of right of way as it would create landlocked lots within the subdivision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that the said land vacation is hereby denied.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission Chair and/or County Manager may finalize and sign any agreements consistent with the terms of this resolution
