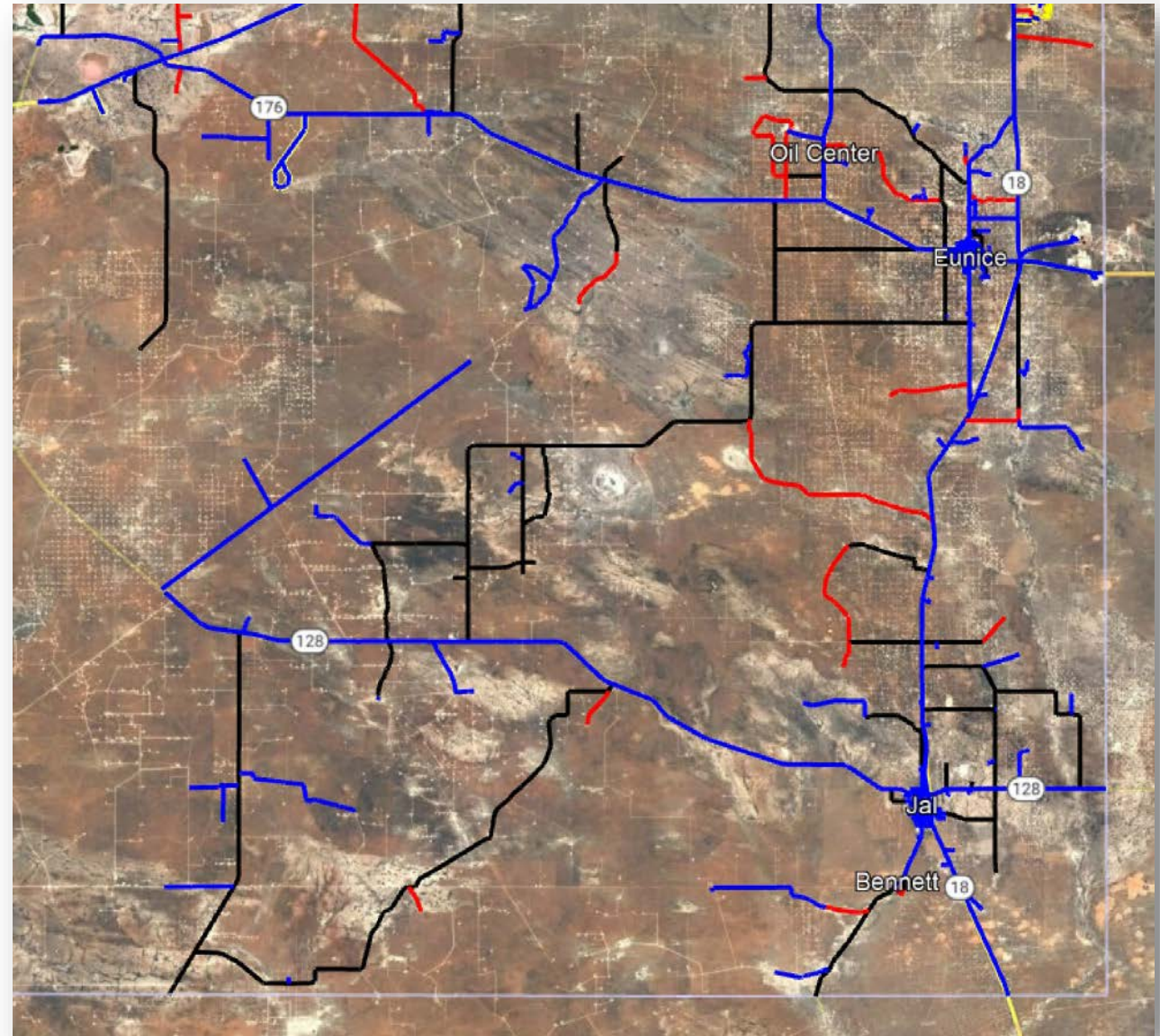


Consideration of Lea County Resolution No. 22-JUN-138R Approving a Task Order with John West Surveying Company for Surveying Services for Teague Switch Roadway

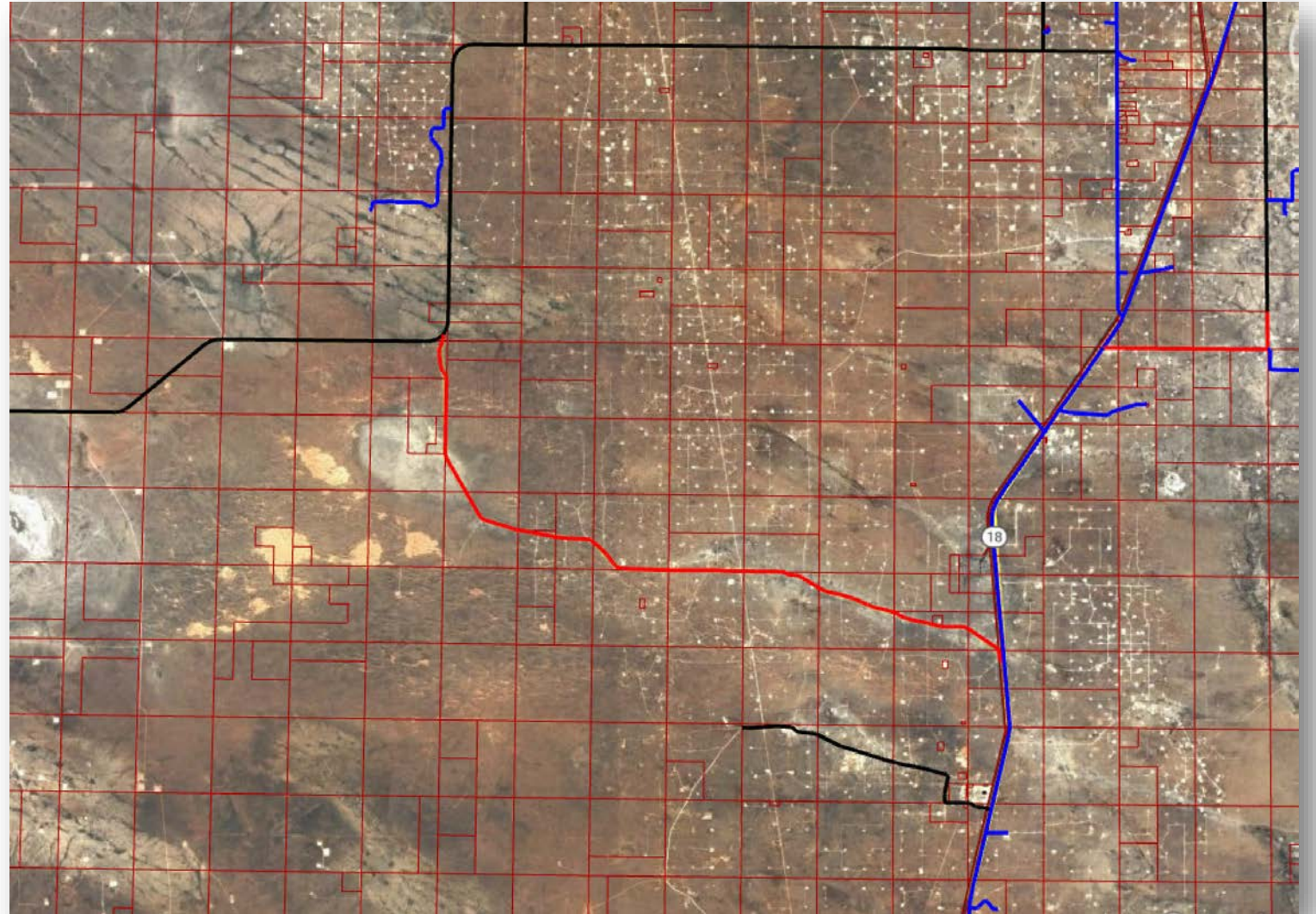
Teague Switch is an approximately 10.5 mile roadway located between Eunice and Jal, NM connecting Delaware Basin roadway with NM 18. The project has been surveyed and designed in 2010 and updated in 2014 but was postponed for higher priority projects.

The roadway is one of the only remaining roadways in the high use energy region of the county that has not been upgraded to a paved surface.



The upgrade will not only improve the safety and surfacing of the roadway, but will also eliminate a large caliche road maintenance issue for Lea County.

Staff recommends hiring the John West Surveying, the original design surveyor, to update the plans to current conditions.


