A RESOLUTION APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN LEA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF HOBBS FOR THE
2022 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2022, the City of Hobbs signed a Memorandum of Understanding to be the fiscal agent for the 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program which awarded \$21,728 to the City of Hobbs and Lea County, New Mexico; *and*

WHEREAS, the funding will be distributed 60/40 with the City of Hobbs Police Department receiving \$13,036.80 and the Lea County Sheriff's Office receiving \$8,691.20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that the Memorandum of Understanding, which is attached hereto, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission Chair and/or County Manager may finalize and sign any agreements consistent with the terms of this resolution.

PASSED AND APPROVED on this 18th day of August, 2022, by the Lea County Board of County Commissioners in an open meeting in Lovington, New Mexico.






