## **Livestock Scholarship Application Form**

The Lincoln County Wyoming Fair Board will be awarding scholarships to Lincoln County Livestock 4-H and FFA members. The deadline to submit applications is May 1, 2022. The Lincoln County Fair Board and Livestock members will decide the amount and number of scholarships awarded. Winners will be announced by June 1, 2022. The winners will be recognized at the Lincoln County Fair Livestock Sale in August.

### **Scholarship Requirements:**

1. You must be a current member of the Lincoln County 4-H or FFA Chapter.
2. You must be a high school senior in good academic standing.
3. The scholarship shall be applied to any college, university or vocational school. Preference will be given to those with career goals in agriculture or agriculture related business.
4. Once proof of enrollment is presented, the scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient for college related expenses.
5. Please be as explicit and thorough as possible.
6. **READ and COMPLETE CAREFULLY – Only completed applications will be considered.** If additional space is needed, please attach a word document. All applications must be typed. **NO HAND WRITTEN APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
