- He/she must have completed Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, or 3rd grade and plans to participate in the Linn County Fair in some way. For example:
 - Clover Kids, Kidde Tractor Pull, Kidde Calf Show, Little Shepard Show
- He/she must complete and **mail** the application to the below address, postmarked no later than **June 10, 2026 (Applications must be mailed to below address to be accepted).**

 - Supper will be provided for the Little Contestants; family is welcome to purchase food from fair vendors and join us during the Royal Supper
- He/she must be present Little Mr. and Miss Coronation **Wednesday, June 24, 2026 at 6:15 p.m.** at the Farm Bureau Pavilion on the Free Stage
 - Contestants are asked to please dress nicely
 - We will take a group photo prior to the crowning
 - We will take a photo of the newly crowned littles after the crowning
