For the past couple of months, we have been sharing some of the internal procedural updates we have made during this "time of no events". Today we would like to turn your attention to some of the external advocacy we have been involved in.

We are part of the Washington Meeting and Convention Coalition; a group that represents convention centers, conference centers and large hotels from across the state of Washington capable of hosting conventions/business events/meetings. The Coalition has drafted a proposal of updated guidelines on reopening the meetings and events industry that will be sent to the Washington State Governor's Office for consideration.

As part of our request, we are asking that the Governor's Office consider these events as a separate classification of gatherings, reconsider how the limits on these events are calculated and when they can be safely restarted.

As authorities in our industry, it is important to have a voice in helping officials make informed decisions. Bringing these proposed guidelines to the table will hopefully help our transition back to normal be smoother.
