The 2026 Fair will also feature a lineup of interactive and family-friendly activities, including All American contests and savings opportunities throughout the event, the debut of the All-American Lemonade Contest highlighting creativity on a classic fair favorite, and a community "Patriotic Bike Parade" inspired by the 250th celebration of America, open to all ages. All the traditional competitions, blue ribbons, livestock shows, ground acts, fair food and more will be in store with a patriotic twist!
