Cow Sculpture

Supplies:

- Black Playdoh
- Brown Playdoh
- White Playdoh
- Pink/Peach Playdoh
- Mat/Silicone Sheet/Pad
- Tools (Plastic Knife, Wooden Dowel, Etc.)
- Pencil
- Wiggle Eyes
- Glue
- Twine
- Small Paper for Tag

Instructions:

Body - Take a large ball of White Playdoh and roll the body into an egg-shaped.

<u>Head-</u> Using the White Playdoh form an egg-shape and slice about a quarter of the smaller part. This is going to a flat side for a snout. Now, use your pink/peach Playdoh and roll onto an oval shape making one side flat, Then place together. You just made the HEAD.

Mouth/Nose and Eyes— Using the end of a dowel, press and indent the nostrils (2) and eyes (2) and use your Knife to carve a mouth. You can place the wiggly eyes in now, but may need a dot a glue to hold in place. Foll out a thin black piece of Playdoh and smash lightly, this will be her eyelashes and place above the eyes. Take a tiny amount of Pink/Peach Playdoh and roll, then smash. place in the nostrils.

<u>Legs-</u> Take the White Playdoh and make (4) legs. you can roll it then flatten the top. Make sure you flatten the feet to stand up. Place on the BODY. Make sure you press into place. Use Brown Playdoh and create (4) round balls for the HOOVES. Flatten both sides (like a coin) and carve the center line for the hoof.

<u>Udder-</u> Use the Pink/Peach Playdoh and create a small egg shape. Flatten one side and press into place. Make (4) small round balls and place onto the Udder.

<u>Tail/Spots</u>- Use the Black Playdoh and roll out a flat sheet. cut out the spots! be creative. No two cows are alike. Place spots on the cow. The tail is a piece of Black Playdoh rolled into a tube About 1 1/2 inch. The hair can be black or brown. make a Tassel like shape and press onto the tail.

Horns/Ears - Use the brown Playdoh and roll out the horns about 1/2 inch and pinch the end to make the horn pointed. Use the White playdoh and create the ears by rolling (2) small balls and pinch one end to point and press the Knife into the center gently to create the crease. Place horns and ears on the HEAD.

Tie a Twine Necklace around her neck! You can name it by placing a name tag on the rope! Use the Template below. Glue it into place.
