

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Groups, schools, churches, businesses and individuals are eligible to enter the contest. You may enter online at https://form.jotform.com/DDorrell/scarecrows-2018-entry.

There are limited spaces for Scarecrows, so spaces will be assigned on a first-come basis.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS SEPTEMBER 7!

Check in and set up will be Saturday, September 29 and Sunday, September 30, 2018 from 1pm to 5pm. Tear down of all displays will be Saturday, November 3 from 10am to 1pm.

Entries must be built to be freestanding and able to sit or stand on its own support base. You may not put anchors into the ground or concrete. All entries must fit within a 3 ft. x 3 ft. area.

No perishable goods that may spoil, harm the environment, or attract animals may be used in the construction of your display.

Creators are responsible for keeping their scarecrow in good viewing and picture taking condition from October 1 through November 3. Displays must be checked regularly and repaired as needed. Any scarecrow deemed "damaged" by the committee must be repaired or removed within 24 hours by its creators.

Entries must be sturdy and weather-resistant. Please keep wind & rain in mind when designing your display.

Scarecrows must remain in good condition from October 1 through November 3, 2018 when displays will be broken down and removed. You are responsible for removal of your display! Display area must be restored to the condition as before scarecrows arrived.

When designing your creation, please keep in mind that this is a family event. No political, religious or violent scarecrows please.

Please no valuable items! The City of Newnan or NCAC WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE for missing or damaged items.

Winners will be chosen by a judging committee of members of the business community in the following categories: Best Theme, Most Creative, Funniest, Spookiest, and Most Creative Use of Materials. One winning entry in each category will receive \$100.
