Exhibitor must bring, proof of ownership and Profile Photo of animal with tag visible to mandatory meeting. A Notarized Exhibitor Liability/Photo release and sales contracts if applicable will be handed in or completed. Releases must be thoroughly completed. Exhibitors must bring a parent/legal guardian to mandatory meeting
Failure to complete the registration will result in disqualification.

Poultry

Notarized Exhibitor Liability/Photo release and sales contracts, if applicable will be completed. Exhibitors must bring a parent/legal guardian to mandatory meeting/inspection.
Failure to complete the registration will result in disqualification.

Swine

Registration is at Manateecountyfair.com. Under Youth Livestock, scroll down to your animal area and click on Showworks. The registration fee is \$15 per head paid with your online registration. Registration is September 21 - October 7, 2021.

Must bring Copy of Proof of ownership **(Bill of sale with 840 RFID # on it)**.

MANDATORY Meeting to be held from 9am-1pm, Sunday, December 5, 2021 at Mosaic Arena. Notarized Exhibitor Liability/Photo release and sales contracts will be handed in or completed.

Exhibitors must bring a parent/legal guardian at check in & mandatory meeting.
Failure to complete the registration will result in disqualification.

Rabbits

Exhibitors must bring a parent/legal guardian to mandatory meeting/inspection.
Failure to complete the registration will result in disqualification.

DOGS

MANDATORY meeting on December 14, 2021, in Rogers Auditorium 4-H Center. You must bring Shot records including rabies or titters, Notarized Exhibitor Liability/Photo release, must be brought to or executed at the Mandatory meeting. Releases must be thoroughly completed.

Exhibitors must bring a parent/legal guardian to mandatory meeting/check-in.
Failure to complete the registration will result in disqualification.

GOATS

Animal Pick-up and Drop-off & Parking

Beef Breeding, Steers, Dairy, Swine, Goats, Rabbits, Poultry and Plants will enter the fairgrounds at Gate 1 on the corner of 17th St. and 14th Ave..

Rabbits and Poultry can be carried in through gate 9 with a Livestock pass

Poultry Meat pen January 20, 2022 in gate 9 out gate 1

Vehicles blocking Gate 1 or 9 will be towed at the owner's expense.

There will be no parking along the west end of the Mosaic arena without a proper pass at any time!

Exhibitors & Parents may use Gate 9 and west end of arena in the morning before 9AM when coming to feed and water animals.

Essentials coming in gate 9 may be dropped off but do not Park vehicle on west side of arena, vehicles will proceed to the livestock parking area. Violators will have their vehicles towed at the owner's expense.

Exhibitor and Parent Security Passes

Exhibitors will be required to make a one-time purchase of a \$25 Security Entrance Pass that will give unlimited access to the fair for the entire run of the Fair. Families will be allowed to purchase (4) additional Security Entrance Passes at \$25 each which also gives unlimited access to the fair.

Passes can be purchased when you register your animal on line through ShoWorks

Last day to purchase passes is October 23, 2021.

If not purchased by October 23, 2021 the cost will be \$30 each with same limits as above.

Add-On Cards

1. Participants must be a bona fide 4-H or FFA member.
2. Non-county participants are ineligible for awards and premium monies.
3. No parents, coaches or other adults will be allowed in designated area with judging contestants.
4. All judging awards will be presented at Awards Ceremony on Saturday January 22, 2022.
5. An electronic grading machine will be used, if available, to tally scores.
