Exhibitors will be required to make a one-time purchase of a \$30 Exhibitor Security

Entrance Pass that will give unlimited access for the ten days of the fair. Families will be allowed to purchase (4) additional Security Entrance Passes at \$25 each which also gives unlimited access to the fair.

Only one gate 8 parking pass per family will be issued for the time their animals are on exhibit, NO EXCEPTIONS. Parking is on a first come basis.

Passes can be purchased when you register your animal on-line through ShoWorks
If not purchased by October 27, 2023, cost will be \$30 for Exhibitors and will not receive a T-shirt.

Additional Family member passes will be \$30 each with same limits as above.

#### **Add-On Cards**

The Manatee River Fair Association will only handle add-on's totaling \$25.00 or more.

Add-on must be received by February 15, 2024.

Add-On checks will be mailed out after April 1, 2024, after each exhibitor's add-on monies are received by the fair office.

## Animal Pick-up and Drop-off & Parking

Beef Breeding, Steers, Dairy, Swine, Goats, Rabbits, Poultry and Plants will enter the fairgrounds at Gate 1 on the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> St. and 14<sup>th</sup> Ave..

Rabbits and Poultry can be carried in through gate 9 with a Livestock Entry Pass Poultry Meat pen drop off January 18, 2024, enter in gate 9 and exit out gate 1

Vehicles Parked by the drainage canal fence or blocking Gate 1 or 9 will be towed at the owner's expense.

## There will be no parking along the west end of the Mosaic arena without a proper pass.

Exhibitors & Parents may use Gate 9 to drop off essentials, but do not park your vehicle on the west of the arena. Once essentials are unloaded vehicles will proceed to the livestock parking area at gate 8. Violators will have their vehicles towed at the owner's expense.
