

Manatee County Rabbit Health Affidavit- Must be turned in to show

The Florida Dept. of Agriculture issued a notice that a single premise rabbit in Orange County tested positive for RHDV-2 (Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease Virus Type 2). 06/29/22. This is the fourth confirmed case of RHDV-2 in FL. States with confirmed cases include: Arizona, California, Colorado, FL, Georgia, Hawaii, Idaho, Kentucky, Mississippi, Montana, NJ, Nevada, New Mexico, NY, Oregon, South Dakota, Tennessee, Utah, Texas, Washington, and Wyoming and Cuba.
