RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Contest is open to all females in the 9th, 10th or 11th grades of the Martin County School District.
2. Contestants must have been a resident of Martin County for the 12 months preceding the opening of the Fair.
3. The Pageant shall be limited to the first 40 female entries.
4. Contestants must be single and never have been married.
5. Past Queens of the Martin County Fair cannot participate.
6. Contestants shall not be related to any of the members of the Miss Martin County Fair Committee or any of the Judges.
7. Preliminary judging, Thursday night, will be based on interview, personality and delivery. Final judging, Friday night, will be based on stage presence, confidence, response to emcee and delivery. The preliminary judging and final judging panels may differ.
8. There will be no swim suit or talent competition.
9. Contestants will be required to formal wear of their choice the night of the pageant. This includes evening or cocktail dresses, pant suits, jumpsuits, or other formal wear approved by the pageant committee.
10. The winner shall portray good morals, manners and conduct. She should conduct herself with dignity at all times and be a credit to the Martin County Fair Association. Attire worn during fair week must be appropriate and cover the midsection and private areas adequately.
11. Failure to follow these rules will be considered cause for dismissal, and the first runner up will resume the responsibilities.
12. Decision of the judges will be final and all scores will be kept confidential.
13. \$1000 Scholarship from the Martin County Fair Association to the Fair Queen. It is the winner's responsibility to collect scholarship funds upon graduating.
14. The Miss Martin County Fair Committee will hold a meet and greet on Monday, January 31, 2022, at 6:00 pm, in Building G, at the Martin County Fairgrounds. **Attendance is highly encouraged; parents are also welcome.**
15. Mandatory Dance Rehearsal, February 7th-10th, 2022. Starting at 6pm. Conflicts need to be communicated to the pageant committee ASAP.
16. The contestant whose name is signed below gives permission to the Miss Martin County Fair Pageant and its Sponsors, to use her photograph, speeches, video, etc., for publicity purposes and future pageant material. Those items become the property of the Martin County Fair Association, Inc.
17. The Queen and all members of the Queen's Court are expected to be a part of all activities during the Fair, and as needed during the year. Appearance schedules will be given to all winners.

The duties of the selected Miss Martin County Fair shall include, but not be limited to the following:

- *Participate in events and livestock shows and auctions during Fair Week*
- *Represent the Martin County Fair Association (as Miss Martin County Fair) at various community and civic events throughout the year when invited to participate.*
- *Opportunity to advance to the Miss Teen FL USA pageant.*

I do hereby declare that I have read the rules and regulations governing this Pageant and so swear that I will abide by them. I am willing to make myself available to The Martin County Fair as outlined above.
