Parks in Mesquite

Mesquite is the ideal setting with more than 70 parks and plenty of outdoor places to explore. Set up a family picnic in picturesque **City Lake Park** that encompasses 20 acres, covered picnic pavilions and a little league baseball field. **Paschall Park** is one of Mesquite's most popular green spaces and home to several city festivals, including the popular Summer Sizzle. **Camp Rorie Galloway** is the perfect location for company retreats and family reunions with a large picnic pavilion, kayaking, ziplining, and a ropes course.

Outdoor Recreation

Mesquite Golf Course features 18 holes across 154 acres. Enjoy a day of golf at this award-winning course. There is also a special discount for visitors staying in Mesquite hotels.

Travis Williams Softball Complex hosts high school and collegiate tournaments throughout the year. Enjoy the sand volleyball courts in **Town East Park** and **Evans Recreation Center**. Soccer enthusiasts can play a game of futbol on fields at **Eastfield College** and throughout the City. Mesquite also has several courses for disc golf at **Paschall Park**, **Porter Park** and **DeBusk Park**. Mesquite Arena is home to the Mesquite Championship Rodeo (June-August), Mesquite Outlaws Soccer League (November-March) as well as large concerts and special events. For more than 60 years, the Mesquite Championship Rodeo has entertained families with thrilling rodeo events such as saddle bronc riding, bull riding, barrel racing, team roping and every other event you'd see at a PRCA Rodeo.

The rodeo includes full scale sports production to highlight all of the action, a private VIP club serving Texas BBQ and the Fan Zone. Beginning at 6 p.m. the night of a rodeo, visitors can come onto the arena floor, interact with rodeo participants and try out their rodeo skills. For children, the Fan Zone includes free pony rides, stick-horse barrel racing, bounce houses, photo opportunities with contestants and talent, delicious barbecue dinner at the onsite BBQ pavilion, and much more.

MESQUITE ARTS CENTER

Mesquite Arts Center

Be sure to make the thriving Mesquite art scene a stop on your next stay. The Mesquite Symphony Orchestra and the Mesquite Community Band consistently performs a dynamic and moving season every year. TOWN EAST MALL Town East Mall
