**PREMIUMS & AWARDS:** Ribbons and premiums will be awarded in classes where there are at least (3) three entries. Please note: Premiums are paid by results as stated in the Official Judge's Book. Ribbons do not constitute a premium.

**1<sup>st</sup> place - \$10.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> place - \$8.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> place - \$6.00**



**BEST OF SHOW AWARDS:** Rosettes will be awarded to the “Best of Show” in each Department, selected from the 1<sup>st</sup> place class winners in each division. **A \$10 premium will be awarded.**

**HERITAGE AWARDS:** A rosette may be awarded by the superintendent or designated team to highlight exhibits throughout all divisions. This recognition does not award a premium amount.

**They will not be mailed by MontanaFair.**

- 3.) All articles entered in this division **must have been finished within the last 12 months**
- 4.) **Mark front side and top of Quilts and Afghans** so they are displayed to your satisfaction.
- 5.) In order to safeguard against loss in this department, no one will be permitted to handle any article once put in place, with the exception of the Judge or Superintendent's staff.
- 6.) After the Entry Deadline, no exhibit shall be moved to another division nor will it be judged in any class other than the class in which it is entered, except by discretion of the Superintendent.
- 7.) MontanaFair is not liable for any errors or omissions from this department information or on the website at [www.montanafair.com](http://www.montanafair.com)

**\*NEW IN 2026:** All exhibitors in Departments K, P and T have the option of selling their work as exhibited.

### SALE OF ARTWORK:

- All sales are final. 25% of the selling price will go to MontanaFair and 75% of the selling price will go to the artist. **Buyers must make payment at time of purchase!**
- Checks will be mailed to seller (exhibitor) as soon as possible after the conclusion of MontanaFair, but no later than 30 days. Artists receiving \$600.00 or more must complete and sign a W-9 form.
- Non-placed items that are purchased during the Exhibitor Reception are to be taken at time of purchase. Purchase of placed exhibits must be picked up, with receipt, August 16, 2026 between 10:00 am and 2:00 pm. MontanaFair and its employees assume no responsibility for artwork purchased and not picked up by this time. Exhibits may be lost, donated, or destroyed after August 16, 2026.
