Moses Lake Demo Race Event Rules Sponsored By Miner Services

The night's events will be Time Trials, Trophy Dash, Heat Races, Powder Puff, Australian Pursuit, and Demo.

POOR SPORTSMANSHIP AND BAD CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AT ANY TIME DURING THE EVENT.

1. If you or anyone associated with your car is involved in an altercation, the driver and all persons involved will be banned from the Demo Derby for LIFE! NO EXCEPTIONS!!
2. All drivers must have a legal, current driver's license **and MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE OR WITH A SIGNED PARENTAL RELEASE FOR AGES 16-17 TO DRIVE A CAR IN THE RACE EVENT. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
3. No convertibles or vans. T-tops must have a roll bar and must be covered.
4. Cars entering Heat Race Only- can repair the front or rear end with parts other than stock.
5. **ALL** glass, trim, metal, fender extensions, and anything breakable must be removed. All car preparation and anything flammable must be completed before entering the pit area. **NO BROKEN GLASS LEFT ANYWHERE IN THE CAR**
6. Wheel wells may be trimmed away; larger stock bumper extensions must be trimmed and not exceed past body. All cars will be free of broken glass and debris before inspection.
7. Batteries must be moved to the driver's compartment in a sealed box or covered. Radiators must remain in the stock location, in front of the engine.
8. All cars must have an H bar behind the driver's seat. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Roll cages are preferred, and the driver's door must be reinforced with thick channel, thick tubing, grader blade (with door cage is preferred). Doors must be secured by bolting, chaining, or welding-no ratchet straps.
9. The middle of the hood **MUST HAVE a 2'x2' OPENING.** Hood and trunk must be secured with a chain or all-threaded, no ratchet straps.
10. The driver must have a helmet with a chin strap and protective eyewear, which must be worn during all races and demos. The helmet must be strapped at all times.
11. Seat belts must be anchored firmly to the car. Harnesses are preferred.
12. The rear seat must be removed; **BRAKES** must be in good working order.
13. Cars will be pre-registered and numbered with your registered number. 1-999 slots are available. **No letters.**
14. Cars must be in self-starting condition at the start of each race. All cars will have 18" high, visible numbers painted on both front doors and the top of the Roof. **Number boards are mandatory with contrasting colors 2'x3'**
15. **NO OBJECTS ABOVE ROOF EXCEPT NUMBER PLATE OR FLAGPOLE.** Flag poles must be a flexible/flimsy pole, like a flag whip. **NO WOOD or SOLID PIPES ALLOWED**
16. A Fire extinguisher must be in the car and secured within reach of the driver, with the hose tied down with clips. A fire suppression system is preferred.

17. No Pets or extra riders in the car at any time.
18. Women can enter either the heat races with the men or enter the Powder Puff Race. Both men and women may enter the Demo Derby event.
19. Only the Driver is allowed in or on the car while on the track
20. Only one tow vehicle is allowed through the gate per registered car. Any other people in the tow vehicle must have a ticket/wristband to enter.
21. No swapping numbers with other cars once your car is registered.
22. D-rings are mandatory, and they are located at the center of the car's front and rear.
23. Any debris on cars after races will be removed.
24. To enter the next race, demo officials will inspect your car as it enters the next race. Any loose material that is deemed unsafe will prevent your participation until the material is removed.
25. No driver or crew member is allowed in or around the announcer's booth at any time during the event.
26. Contesting placement will require clear video proof to present to the official at North Gate. GoPro Video footage is not an acceptable form of footage.
27. Poor welds on the front and rear bumpers will be rejected at inspection
30. Stock fuel lines need to be inspected for brittleness, and the letter "E" (4" x 6") on both sides of the car for Electric fuel pumps.
31. Rear Wheel Drive cars need to have a mud flap(Rear Skirt) that is one solid piece and wraps around the rear fender to the rear fender. ***Refer to the picture at the end of the Document***
32. Disrespect and frustration towards sign-up personnel, Flaggers, or the demo committee will not be tolerated.

FEES

1. Cars registered for the event will pay a fee of \$25-
2. The fee is \$25 to enter the Ladies' Race. The lady driver must check in at the back gate and get a wristband.
3. **NO PIT PASSES!**
4. **Any other person wanting to help with your car will be required to pay the price of General Admission Ticket in the Demo Derby.**
5. Tickets will be available for purchase online or at the Blue and Green Gate.
6. Tuesday's Australian Pursuit will be a Total of 50 cars, with 10 cars per heat, with a \$100 entry fee, **Only 1 entry per car.**
7. Wednesday Australian Pursuit will be unlimited, entry fee is \$50 per car. **Only 1 entry per car.**
8. Race entries will be accepted online and at the GREEN GATE during the first week of August, in the Rodeo office. The office is located at the Fairgrounds Drive off Paxson.
9. The **DEADLINE** for race car/demo entries is 3 pm on the day of the Event.
