

HORSES – DIVISION 215

Open Class

1. All stalls must be reserved by July 15. No late entries can be guaranteed a stall. An Animal fee of \$15.00 to be paid at the time of registration.
2. No truck can be unloaded without visual inspection by a veterinarian. A veterinarian will be at the Southeast Gate ONLY, 1 p.m. – 8 p.m. on Wednesday.
3. Horses must remain in their stalls except while being exhibited or for brief exercise periods.
4. Any horse that is unruly or otherwise ailing may be removed from the fairgrounds at the department superintendent's discretion.
5. All horses must be judged in halter class.
6. All horses in all classes may be shown in snaffle bit, regardless of horse's age.
7. No person under age 18 may show stallions over 12 month old. No stallions in performance classes.
8. Halter judging will be at 10 am Friday. Stallions will show first, followed by mares and geldings.
9. Fitting & Showing will be Friday.
10. English classes 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, Western classes 10:00 a.m. Saturday
11. Trail Classes will follow on Saturday.
12. Horses stalled in Open Horse Barn cannot enter rodeo events.
13. Horse handling rules: See E General Rules & Regulations.
14. Stall decorations are mandatory, with an emphasis on education. Good herdsmanship is required.
15. All participants must wear boots and helmets.
16. No cross entry between lots 16 & 17.
17. 4-H, FFA, and Grange Youth members may enter lot 18-Cart Class only.

General Health Requirements, See General Rules & Regulations, Section D.

- No premium will be paid for more than one entry in any lot in each breed shown by the same exhibitor
- Only standard varieties shall compete.
- All standard varieties of poultry, including Bantams, are eligible for competition for premiums.
- Fowls deemed unworthy will not be awarded a premium.
- The exhibitor is responsible for feeding and watering exhibits.
- Special ribbons at the judges' discretion may be given. Ribbons only, no premiums paid.

RULES FOR EXHIBITING

1. All rabbits are to be shown by breed.
2. It is suggested that all exhibited rabbits have a permanent ear number for identification.
3. This tattoo should be recorded on entry tag BEFORE animal is placed in coop.
4. All exhibits will be judged according to the ARBA Standard of Perfection.
5. All Standard breeds will be accepted.
6. Animals will be weighed at the judge's request, and these weights shall govern during the judging.
7. Animals deemed unfit due to insects or disease will not be accepted for exhibit. This is at the department chairperson's discretion.
8. Each exhibitor will be allowed only one entry per lot, per breed & variety.
9. The exhibitor is responsible for the feeding and watering of his or her exhibits.
