- Animals registered in the AICA Colored Division Registry (QF and QM initialed registration numbers) must meet the parameters of the AICA Color Card.
- The use of a coloring agent, flock and powder is prohibited.
- · Cattle should be in the Junior Exhibitors name on the registration paper by September 1st, 2021.
