2021 NILE Futurity RULES

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to compete in any NILE Gold Buckle Select Futurity, horses must meet the following requirements:

- Pay all required entry fee(s) before entry deadline.
- Submit proper entry form to the NILE office before entry deadline.
- Be the proper age for the class entered.
- Meet necessary purchase or nomination requirements for the class entered.
 - Be purchased through a NILE Gold Buckle Select Horse Sale
 - Eligibility begins after the horse has been accepted to the horse sale. Meaning horses can compete the same year they are consigned to the sale.
 - Be sired by a NILE Nominated Stallion (nomination must be current).
 - The nominated stallion is also eligible to compete in his age-appropriate class.

SHOW FORMAT:

Yearling futurity entries will show in halter class and round pen class. Two-Year-Old futurity entries will show in trail class including reining maneuvers. Three-Year-Old, Four-Year-Old, and Five-Year-Old & Up futurity entries will show in reining class and cow work class. Barrel futurity entries will run a barrel pattern during the Runnin' the Rims Barrel Race.

SALE DISCOUNT:

Any horse entered and showing in the futurity can receive a discount of \$25 OFF the NILE Gold Buckle Select Horse Sale consignment fee. Discount only available for the same year shown. The sale consignment must meet all regular horse sale consignment rules (i.e. consignment form and consignment fee received before deadline).

ENTRY FEES:

An office fee of \$10 will be deducted from each entry. Cattle fees will be deducted from each entry in a cow work class (3, 4, 5 & up). Absolutely **no refunds**. Those not participating in the futurity events will forfeit all money paid in.

BREEDER/OWNER PURSE SPLIT:

The breeder of the horse will receive 15% of winnings. The owner of record at time of futurity will be paid the balance. Breeder's share is paid to the breeder listed on the registration papers. Eligibility will remain with the horse regardless of changes in ownership after entry.

NOMINATED STALLIONS:

The nominated stallion and his progeny are eligible to enter their age-appropriate futurity class. Nomination entry form and nomination fee are required. Nominated stallions receive ¼-page advertisement in sale catalog, listing on NILE website, PA mentions during show, and NILE promotion. Stallions must be nominated each year. Eligibility will remain regardless of changes in ownership after entry or nomination.

RULES FOR ALL CLASSES:

Riders and/or handlers will show in western attire (See AQHA SHW320.1).

All horses will be shown in western stock saddle (See AQHA SHW305.8).

All horses will be shown in legal bits and head gear as outlined in the AQHA rule book (2020 edition, pages 4-5 and SHW556.10-12).

No braided tails or tail extensions will be allowed. The mane may be banded or braided.

Lame or unsound horses will be severely penalized.

BARREL FUTURITY:

Open to any horse 3-years-old or older that has been either purchased through the NILE Gold Buckle Select Horse Sale or sired by a NILE Nominated Stallion. The NILE Barrel Futurity will **run in conjunction with Runnin' the Rims Barrel Race, held on Sunday, October 17th**. If entered in both the Runnin' the Rims Barrel Race and the NILE Barrel Futurity the horse will **ONLY** run once. The run will be during the futurity section and the run time will carry over for Runnin' the Rims time. Paid in 2D Format /.5/

YEARLING FUTURITY:

Open to any horse born in 2020 that has been either purchased through the 2020 NILE Gold Buckle Select Horse Sale or sired by a NILE Nominated Stallion (See Stallion Nominations section for qualifications). The class will be judged in two parts: halter followed by round pen. Scores for the two portions will be added together for the final score (score sheet provided by NILE). The halter portion will be judged on conformation. Points will be awarded to each horse based on their placing in the halter portion. For example, in a class with 14 horses first place will be awarded 14 points, second place will be awarded 13 points, etc. The round pen portion will be judged on movement, training, and manners. Horses must complete at least one circle each direction at the walk, jog, and lope. Lead line must be removed after entering round pen and CANNOT be used as a whip or encouragement during round pen work. Halter may be left on or removed. Lunge whips are optional. Only traditional lunge whips are allowed. The following are NOT allowed: flags, carrot sticks, trainers stick, halter whips, whips, or crops. Horses shall be marked down for excessive play in the round pen. Time starts when gate closes. There will be a 2-minute time limit to complete round pen work with a warning given at one minute remaining.

TWO-YEAR-OLD FUTURITY:

Open to any horse born in 2019 that has been either purchased through the NILE Gold Buckle Select Horse Sale or sired by a NILE Nominated Stallion (See Stallion Nominations section for qualifications). Horses will be shown in a trail class with reining maneuvers, including but not limited to trot over poles, bridge, gate, pick-up and carry a slicker, load in trailer, and lope both directions. Pattern will be determined by NILE officials and posted prior to show day.

THREE-YEAR-OLD FUTURITY:

Open to any horse born in 2018 that has been either purchased through the NILE Gold Buckle Select Horse Sale or sired by a NILE Nominated Stallion (See Stallion Nominations section for qualifications). The class will be judged in two parts: reining followed by cow work. Scores for the two portions will be added together for the final score (score sheets provided by NILE). Horses will show first in a reining pattern (pattern selected by NILE officials). At completion of reining pattern, the rider will hesitate and call for a cow. Cow work will follow AQHA rules (SHW564.1) **BOX-DRIVE-BOX-DRIVE**. Horses will work individually boxing a cow at the end of the arena, driving the cow down the fence, boxing the cow at the opposite end of the arena, and then driving the cow back down the fence past the middle of the arena. 1 minute and 45 second time limit to complete cow work with warning given when 50 seconds remain.

FOUR-YEAR-OLD FUTURITY:

Open to any horse born in 2017 that has been either purchased through the NILE Gold Buckle Select Horse Sale or sired by a NILE Nominated Stallion (See Stallion Nominations section for qualifications). The class will be judged in two parts: reining followed by cow work. Scores for the two portions will be added together for the final score (score sheets provided by NILE). Horses will show first in a reining pattern (pattern selected by NILE officials). At completion of reining pattern, the rider will hesitate and call for a cow. Cow work will follow AQHA rules (SHW505.3) BOX-FENCE-CIRCLE. Horses will work individually boxing a cow at the end of the arena, taking the cow down the fence, making at least one turn each direction on the fence and then circling the cow in each direction.

FIVE-YEAR-OLD & UP FUTURITY:

Open to any horse born in 2016 or earlier that has been either purchased through the NILE Gold Buckle Select Horse Sale or sired by a NILE Nominated Stallion (See Stallion Nominations section for qualifications). The class will be judged in two parts: reining followed by cow work. Scores for the two portions will be added together for the final score (score sheets provided by NILE). Horses will show first in a reining pattern (pattern selected by NILE officials). At completion of reining pattern, the rider will hesitate and call for a cow. Cow work will follow AQHA rules (SHW563.1) BOX-FENCE-ROPE. Horses will work individually boxing a cow at the end of the arena, then taking the cow down the fence and making at least one turn each way on the fence. Next, the contestant shall rope and stop the animal, then return it to the catch pen. Two-loop limit. 3-minute time limit to complete cow work with warning given when 1-minute remains.
