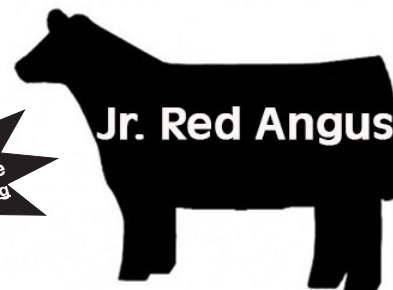

### See Livestock Rules & Regulations located at front of the book

- To be eligible to show in a nationally sponsored Red Angus Junior Show, each exhibitor must be a member of the National Junior Red Angus Association by check-in.
- Entries in any Junior Heifer Show must conform to the General Regulations pertaining to entries-in open shows.
- Classes for the this show will follow the National Junior Show classes.
- All junior heifer entries in the Regional Junior Heifer Show will be eligible for competition in the open show. An entry fee for the open show would be required.
- Exhibitors must have Official Ownership at the time of entry deadline, September 1st, 2022.
- Exhibitors must be the only recorded owner on record in the RAAA database of each animal they exhibit excluding bred and owned bulls.
- Bulls exhibited in the Red Angus National Junior Show must be under 18 months of age as of the publicized show date and be bred and owned by the exhibitor and exhibitor must be a recorded owner of record with a minimum of 50% ownership.
- All bulls 9 months of age or older on publicized date of show must be shown with a nose lead.
- Following processing, the number of entries of Bred and Owned females and bulls will be evaluated by an authorized representative of the RAAA, and classes will be set according to the age that best encourages fair competition.

See page 20 for monetary premiums. NILE will award the champion Jr. breeding heifer a NILE jacket and the reserve champion Jr. breeding heifer a NILE vest.

  17. Mature Cow & Calf - Cow must be born before Jan. 1, 2020.  
Calf must be under 250 days of age and still nursing.

- 28. Bred & Owned Heifer - Junior member must be the breeder and sole owner of the heifer.
- 29. Bred & Owned Bull - Junior member must be the breeder and recorded owner on record with a minimum of 50% ownership.

**Showmanship:** *Please pre-enter on your entry form*

- 30. Junior Showmanship - Only open to JRA Members 8 - 13 years of age as of Oct. 22, 2022. *Junior Showmanship competitors must exhibit an animal they exhibited in a prior class of this show\*\**
- 31. Intermediate Showmanship - Only open to JRA Members 14-17 years of age as of Oct. 22, 2022. *Intermediate Showmanship competitors must exhibit an animal they exhibited in a prior class of this show\*\**
- 32. Senior Showmanship - Only open to JRA Members who are 18 and up to 21 years of age as of Oct. 22, 2022. *Senior Showmanship competitors must exhibit an animal they exhibited in a prior class of this show\*\**
