Kitchen Food Preparation _____

Work in the NIOSA Kitchen prior to the event skewering meat for the Bongo K-Bob booth. Includes complimentary ticket for entry into the event during the week.

Staging /Teardown _____

Setup and teardown of NIOSA booths, stages, areas, etc. Staging begins 1-week prior to NIOSA and teardown begins the Saturday after NIOSA. Includes building booths, decorating, delivering appliances and equipment.

NIOSA Event - Booth Worker _____

Shifts are generally from 4:30 - 8:00 p.m. and 7:30 - 11:00 p.m. Work in booths to prepare and serve foods, assist with cleanup, etc. Booth workers are encouraged to dress in costumes or Fiesta wear that reflect the area they work in.

NIOSA Event – Alcohol Booth Worker _____

Shifts are generally from 4:30 - 8:00 p.m. and 7:30 - 11:00 p.m. Work in booths to prepare and serve beverages, assist with cleanup, etc. Booth workers are encouraged to dress in costumes or Fiesta wear that reflect the area they work in. MUST BE AT LEAST 30 YEARS OLD AND BE TABC CERTIFIED

NIOSA Event - Gates _____

Volunteers are needed to work from 4:30 p.m. until approximately 10:00 p.m. to scan tickets at the gates or sell and reload credits on RFID wristbands for purchase of food and drinks.
