Setup and teardown of NIOSA booths, stages, areas, etc. Staging begins 1-week prior to NIOSA and teardown begins the Saturday after NIOSA. Includes building booths, decorating, delivering appliances and equipment.

Shifts are generally from 4:30 - 8:00 p.m. and 7:30 - 11:00 p.m. Work in booths to prepare and serve beverages, assist with cleanup, etc. Booth workers are encouraged to dress in costumes or Fiesta wear that reflect the area they work in. **MUST BE AT LEAST 30 YEARS OLD AND BE TABC CERTIFIED**
