



2026 NLBFR Check In Rules



-These rules are effect for Check In for the NLBRA National Finals Rodeo.

Please read carefully.

(subject to change)

1) Every contestant must be checked in by **Noon on Saturday 6/27/2026.**

- All trailers must go through check-in located at the NW corner of the OKC Fair.
- If you are going to be late, please call the office with a valid reason.
- The only exceptions will be those Jr High short go contestants.
- Horse check-in procedures will be strictly enforced. Please bring all the necessary paperwork for each animal. Form is located on the website.
- Stalls must be in your name or you will be turned away. Stalls are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- Will utilize a zone process based on stall assignments

- Every contestant must check in with the office to obtain their contestant packets, with or without horses. Bring completed paperwork to the on-site National Office.
- 2) Early Check In is available starting Thursday 6/25/2026 at 9 am through Midnight Friday 6/26/2026.
- Your early arrival camping must correspond with the dates you paid for on the OKC camping site.
 - Any early arrival days for stalling will be \$25 per day per stall.
 - This must be paid for at the time you collect your contestant packet in the National Office.
- 3) Upon arrival, you will have horses unloaded and inspected.
- Horse Health Certificates are required for every horse.
 - Horse Check In Paperwork is required for every horse. Contestants with horses must bring their signed horse paperwork to the office to obtain their contestant packets.
 - Horses will then be taken to their designated stalls.
- 4) After horse inspections, trailers will be moved to the trailer clean out locations.
- Dump locations / trash polycarts are available in all barns and should be used for disposal of horse manure and waste.
- 5) After trailer clean out,
- Dump locations will be available for trailer clean out.
 - After trailer clean out, you will be taken to your designated campsite area.
