## Some important dates to be on the lookout for:

- The camping and stall release date is scheduled for March 19<sup>th</sup> 2020. For those of you who reserved your camp spot during the 2019 NLBRA Finals you will still need to log on and purchase your stalls. Please note that every effort is made to get your stalls as close to your camp spot as possible but this is not a guarantee depending on the type of stall you order. If you have requests you are welcome to call the National Office after the release however give the office a couple of weeks after the release prior to calling because stall assignments will not take place until sometime in April. Continue to check the website over the next month for additional details and also the maps and locations of available spots so you are prepared on the morning of the 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Please remember that when making plans for next year's finals the NLBRA cannot guarantee any
  early arrivals in the pavement areas or in the permanent stall barns. If you are planning on
  coming early and this includes for the team roping, please make plans to reserve your spots in the
  grass areas and in the temporary stall barns. This will be the only way we can guarantee you will
  be allowed to park when you arrive early.
- Top Hand shirts will be sent out this spring as well. Once they are received here in the National Office, we will send the heads up that they are on the way. Please remember that your jean cards will be attached to the shirt tag so please watch for them to not mistakenly dispose of them. We will make every effort possible to get them as soon as available but they may not arrive until April this year.
- Finals entries will open up May 19<sup>th</sup> and will remain open through June 17<sup>th</sup>. You will be able to enter online again this year and paper entries will also be accepted. Please note that no late entries will be accepted and the deadline will be at 5:00 PM on the night of the 17<sup>th</sup>. Please watch for more information in the upcoming months.
- Golf carts can be reserved anytime now through Mile High Golf Carts. There is a link on the website and if you have any questions of problems there contact information is on there as well.
