#### If you cannot enter online, you may still enter your items at entry drop off.

Bring in entry: Saturday, August 3 from 10 am to 2 pm to the Phillips 66 Building. Enter the Fairgrounds through Gate 1. The entrance for the Phillips 66 Building will be by the Expo Building street side. Please do not drive onto the Fairgrounds.

#### Pick up entry and ribbon on Sunday after the fair from 10 am to 2 pm.

The Open Class Art Department encourages artists of all ages and abilities to display their work at the Fair. Please share your Artwork for our community to enjoy during the Fair.

- NO EARLY PICK-UP OF EXHIBITS ARE PERMITTED
- Original paintings and drawings completed in the past two years and not previously shown at the Northwest Washington Fair are eligible.
- Entries must be suitably framed and equipped with <u>screw eyes and wire for hanging</u>. No saw-tooth hangers. All paint and varnish must be dry.
- Label on back of entry with name, age, phone number and art medium used.
- The department reserves the right to reclassify entries deemed improperly classified, select, and eliminate work to be exhibited, and reject work for any reason such as size, fragility, inappropriateness, or infringement of rules.
- Exhibitors may submit 2 entries in this department.
- No entry fees are required, and no free admission will be issued to the exhibitor.
- Online entries still require you to bring your item in at the listed times. Online entries do not guarantee a spot if the space is full when you arrive.
- After Sunday release time security is no longer available and entries may be moved.
- The judge will be an artist or teacher or critic of established reputation in the field of art.
- No artwork shall be advertised or priced for sale.
- NO artwork will be released early; doing so will result in forfeit of premium.
- ONLY family friendly artwork. NO NUDE etc....Contact the Superintendent if you have any questions.
