All exhibitors must be registered online. Please sign up for at least one 4-H in Action online by the deadline. Additional 4-H in Actions may be signed up for during Fair in the Farm Pavilion.

- 1) This is a non-judged activity. Activity must relate to the exhibitor's 4-H project.
- 2) **Open to all 4-H members including Cloverbuds.**
- 3) This activity is not as formal as a presentation; however, it should be planned. Individuals, teams, and groups are encouraged to share an activity with the public. Information should be presented, and questions be answered. 4-H in Actions are suggested to be about 40 minutes to an hour in length.
- 4) 4-H in Action exhibitors are expected to:
 - Share their first name
 - Dress cleanly and neatly
 - Display Information about the activity
 - Engage the public
- 5) Examples of activities that would work well in this type of demonstration are: spinning wool, using a sewing machine to construct a garment, repurposing recycled items, construction of craft items, quilting, knitting, crocheting or sewing, showing how cameras work, beading, painting, how to draw, slime, edit photos, create a stepping stone, cross stitch, flower arrangements, showing how to build something, or Legos.
- 6) Please note: Due to Health Department regulations, the public is no longer allowed to sample 4-H foods or drinks created in 4-H cooking contests, demonstrations, presentations, 4-H in Action or any other form of public 4-H activity. Please have recipe cards printed available to the visiting public.
- 7) You are responsible for providing all supplies and equipment necessary to complete your 4-H in Action. A table and chair will be provided.
- 8) Time needs to be scheduled when registering online. An exhibitor can enter more during the Fair in the 4-H area in the Farm Pavilion. A sign-up sheet will be available on the first day of the Fair. Schedule priority is given to online entries.
- 9) **Exhibitor must indicate on the schedule they completed their 4-H in Action or 4-H Information Booth shift.**
