Parents of 4-H & FFA Season Pass \$30
4-H & FFA Exhibitors - \$20.00 for a 4-H/FFA Season Wristband
4-H Club Leaders & FFA Advisors will receive (1) Complimentary 4-H/FFA Season Pass

**Exhibits are due between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. on Monday August 3 in the Farm Pavilion.**

Two non-registered entries will be accepted at the time of exhibit drop off.

**Entries and ribbons should be picked up on the Sunday following Fair between 12 pm and 2 pm.** Entries not picked up will be left unsecured and may be moved.

1. Entries with incomplete information may be refused.
2. Entries are limited to arts and crafts made by entrants during the current 4-H year.
3. 4-Hers must be entered in 4-H Project Area related to their entry.
4. **All entries must be accompanied by a 3"x 5" index card on which the exhibitor has legibly printed the following information:** The judges are interested in your process and will read this as 10% of judging. Be thorough!
  - a. **Your entry number (no names please).** You will receive this number when the item is checked in.
  - b. **Your Age**
  - c. **Title of Item (What it is)** This is important if entry get separated from paperwork.
  - d. **Construction (What materials and techniques were used)**
5. Each fine arts item in Division B, and any other exhibit intended to be displayed by hanging, must have a hanging device securely attached. Screw eyes and wire are best. If a hanging device is missing or inadequate, the exhibit may be dropped one ribbon placing and may not be displayed. Duct tape, finishing line are not appropriate devices. Framed art and canvas on frame must have screw eyes and wire. There are adhesive hanging devices for light weight mats. Superintendent reserves the right to refuse any entry with inadequate hanging device.
6. Please note for Division B, a canvas that has been stretched and attached to a wood framework is not considered "framed" and will not be accepted as is, unless the "Art" wraps all the way around the edges covering all of the canvas.

## **DIVISION A – CLOVERBUD ARTS & CRAFTS**

Four entries per Cloverbud Exhibitor. Entries will not be judged. 4-H Age 5-7 years old.

PREMIUM: \$3.00

### CLASS NUMBER

1. Fine Art – drawing or painting
2. Applied Art - crafts

## **DIVISION B - FINE ARTS**

Four entries total allowed per exhibitor in Division B. The Superintendent reserves the right to refuse any entry with an inadequate hanging device. Tape, string, duct tape, fishing line are not considered adequate.

PREMIUMS: Blue \$5.00 Red \$3.00 White \$2.00

### CLASS NUMBER

1. Drawing on canvas: charcoal, pen, ink, pencil, other, matted or framed
2. Drawing on paper: charcoal, pen, ink, pencil, other, framed
3. Painting on canvas: watercolor, tempera, oil, acrylic, other, matted or framed
4. Painting on paper: watercolor, tempera, oil, acrylic, other, framed

## **DIVISION C - APPLIED ARTS**

Eight entries are allowed per exhibitor in Division C, with no more than one entries per class. Painted stones belong in Class 2 or 14. Superintendent may not be able to display large items due lack of space.

PREMIUMS: Blue \$5.00 Red \$3.00 White \$2.00

### CLASS NUMBER

1. Christmas decorations/ornaments (no items from kits)
2. General Media Craft: clay, glass, metal, leather, fiber, stone, other (no items made from a kit)
3. Glass: all blown, stained glass, pottery, ceramics that involved firing
4. Items made from kits: includes all pre-cut wood items and paint-by-number
5. Jewelry: all jewelry, regardless of method (no items made from a kit)
6. Metalwork items
7. Nature Crafts: all major components are found in nature
8. Needle Arts: stitchery, weaving, latch hook (no items from kits)
9. Paper crafting: cards, paper quilling, box making, origami (no items from kits)
10. Book crafts: scrapbooks, book making, page folding art, book art
11. Printmaking: relief, lithograph, screen (no items from kits)
12. Recycled Art: project is completely made of reclaimed items. Items that have been used and otherwise would be thrown away (with exception of adhesive).
13. Wood items (no items from kits)
14. Yard Art: any art created with the expectation of being outside
15. Cosplay or anime outfit component or accessory: one or more pieces of a cosplay or anime outfit depicting a specific character crafted by the exhibitor
16. Other applied arts

## **DIVISION D - 4-H CRAFTERS CHALLENGE**

Available to any 4-H member including Cloverbuds. No premiums will be given. Limited to the first 20 exhibitors each day. Priority will be given to exhibitors who registered online. **Tuesday and 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday during Fair from 3 pm to 5 pm in the Peoples Bank Farm Pavilion building.** The Superintendent will have all the craft supplies for you to create a craft using only the supplies given. Bring your creative thinking caps and have fun. These art projects may be taken home when judging is completed.
