# 4-H CLOTHING AND TEXTILES DEPT. 44

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**Entries can be placed online until July 24th.**

<b>4-H &amp; FFA EXHIBITORS:</b>

**Entries must be turned in to the Peoples Bank Farm Pavilion on Monday August 4 from 3 pm to 7 pm. Two late entries will be accepted at drop off. Please park outside Gate 1 and walk around the Farm Pavilion.**

**Entries should be picked up on the Sunday following the fair from 12 pm to 2 pm in the Farm Pavilion.**

- Each item **MUST HAVE** a 3x5 card generated by the exhibitor with a description of the item, member name, member age, and number of years in the project. Entries without a complete 3x5 card will not be judged.
- 4-Hers must have registered for a related 4-H project area such as Clothing, Textiles, and Adventures in Family Living Project Members.
- All items must have been sewn since last year's fair.
- Entries must be sewn by the exhibitor. Entries can be sewn either by hand or machine.
- Each item must have entry tag attached and a care label attached, or an attached 3 x 5 card giving care instructions. Care labels and patterns need to have exhibitor name on them.
- If a commercial pattern is used, include pattern instruction sheet in a plastic bag pinned to garment. If construction varies from pattern instructions, indicate what changes were made.
- All quilts must be finished with a binding.
- If members do not use a commercial pattern include an ADDITIONAL 3 x 5 card explaining where the concept came from and how you completed your item.
- Soiled garments, items showing wear, or garments that have not been ironed will not be judged.
- Exhibits may be made from new or recycled fabric. If fabric is recycled, please specify on your 3 x 5 card.
- Exhibitor may make 3 items per class, all items must be a different style or pattern. A different color fabric does not qualify as different, a different fabric type, i.e. fleece, and denim, and vinyl would qualify.

## **DEPT. 44 - CLOTHING AND TEXTILES**

### **BEGINNING SEWING**

PREMIUMS: Blue \$5.00 Red \$4.00 White \$3.00

#### CLASS NUMBER

1. Beginning project
2. Easy to sew garment
3. Easy to sew personal item or bag
4. Easy to sew home accessory

Collection of 2 or more items made from the same pattern. Each collection must include a 3x5 card identifying the first item sewn, what needed improvement and how they improved on the second and following items. Collections will be judged on exhibitor's ability to identify needed improvements and to show progress in those areas by improving sewing ability. If submitted without a card the collection will not be judged.

### **INTERMEDIATE SEWING**

8. Garment using at least one of the following intermediate techniques - zipper, collar, buttonholes, waist band, etc.
9. Bag or other home article using intermediate techniques such as a zipper or buttonholes
10. Lounge wear or sportswear with simple construction techniques
11. Outer garment with simple construction techniques
12. Other simple sewing, (home item, etc.) that does not fit into other classes
13. Mended garment using simple sewing - i.e., repairing a hem, sewing on loose button, repairing a seam. Must include photo of before the repair has been made.
14. Mended home or craft item using simple sewing - i.e., repairing a hem, sewing on loose button, repairing a seam. Must include photo of before the repair has been made.
15. Costume with simple sewing techniques
16. Serging edges finishing an intermediate level sewn item

## **CHALLENGING SEWING**

PREMIUMS: Blue \$7.50 Red \$6.00 White \$5.00

### CLASS NUMBER

17. Outerwear, garment, intricate or knit
18. Any simple garment or article made from a fabric type you have not worked with before. Attach a 3 x 5 card describing the new construction techniques you learned in sewing on the fabric.
19. Mended or darned garment - moderate difficulty - i.e., darning or mending a tear. Must include photo of garment before the darning or mending has been made.
20. Other item of moderate difficulty that does not fit into other classes
21. Costume, difficult
22. Serger used in construction of a challenging level sewn item

## **ADVANCED SEWING**

### CLASS NUMBER

23. Remade garment. Must include a photo of garment before remaking and a 3 x 5 card explaining what process was taken to remake the garment.
24. Any garment with two or more of the following construction details: collars, cuffs, buttonholes, zipper, or pocket
25. Any item or bag with two or more of the following construction details: buttonholes, zipper, pockets, or attached hardware
26. Any advanced garment or article made from a fabric type you have not worked with before. Attach a 3 x 5 card describing new construction techniques you learned in sewing on this fabric
27. Serger used in construction of an advanced level sewn item

## **CHALLENGING ADVANCED SEWING**

PREMIUMS: Blue \$12.00 Red \$10.00 White \$8.00

### CLASS NUMBER

28. Tailored garment
29. Outerwear, challenging, fully lined
30. Other difficult project that does not fit into other class
31. 2 piece outfit consisting of 2 or more coordinated separates constructed by the exhibitor that can be work together, such as skirt and blouse, pants, vest, and shirt. Items will be judged as a single entry.
32. Serger used in construction of an challenging advanced level sewn item
