# 4-H EDUCATIONAL DISPLAYS

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**Entries can be placed online until July 8**

<b>4-H &amp; FFA EXHIBITORS:</b>
4-H and FFA gate passes must be purchased online by July 20
Parents of 4-H & FFA Season Pass \$30
4-H & FFA Exhibitors - \$20.00 for a 4-H/FFA Season Wristband
4-H Club Leaders & FFA Advisors will receive (1) Complimentary 4-H/FFA Season Pass

Posters, Charts, and Club Banner must be brought in on Saturday July 13 from 10 AM to 2 PM in the Peoples Bank Farm Pavilion. One additional poster or chart can be entered per exhibitor at time of entry drop off.

Table Displays and Club Booths must be registered online. Entries for the Table Displays and Club Booths must be brought to the Peoples Bank Farm Pavilion on Saturday August 3 from 10 AM to 2 PM.

**Entries and ribbons should be picked up on the Sunday following the fair from noon to 2 pm in the Farm Pavilion.**

1. Posters and charts may be entered one year only.
2. Clubs wanting their posters for displaying in the barns the week of the fair need to email the superintendent by the end of July, otherwise posters will be displayed in the Farm Pavilion and animal barns. Please Do Not tell the Superintendent the time of check in, please email with your club name.
3. Entries may be stapled or tacked for displaying unless exhibitor attaches tabs for hanging.
4. Please make sure your club name, exhibitor name, current year and age division (Junior, Intermediate, or Senior) MUST be on the back of each entry.
5. Cloverbud posters need to be entered in the Cloverbud Division.
6. Limited to a total of four entries per exhibitor in division's A and B combined.
7. Size can vary from a minimum of 14" x 22" to a maximum of 28" x 22"
8. No foam, tri-fold or science board will be accepted.
9. Posters and lettering must be readable from 10 feet.
10. No copyrighted illustrations or cartoons may be used in educational displays or posters.
11. No posters will be available for presentations. No exceptions. Exhibitors must make an additional poster that they do not enter to use for presentations.
12. Any questions on the difference between a poster or chart, please contact the Superintendent.
13. No posters are to be taken down once they are on display, NO EXCEPTIONS. If they are taken down the exhibitor will forfeit their premium.
14. Posters need to be educational/4-H related, no quotes or verses should be used. Contact the superintendent with any questions.
15. If you cannot find your poster during fair, if it has to do with an animal, check that animal barn otherwise please contact the superintendent for help locating your poster.
16. The Educational Score card at this link [WSU Extension Publications | Educational Display Score Card](#) will be used to judge all entries.

## **DIVISION C - CLUB BANNER**

Posters, Charts, and Club Banner must be brought in on Saturday July 12 from 10 AM to 2 PM in the Farm Pavilion.

- Each club may enter one banner per year representing their club. The banner may be exhibited for premiums the first year only. If you would like to display your banner again in successive years, it would be on a display basis only - no premium.
- Banner is to be made of fabric. Loops or seams must be part of banner for hanging. Add weights in corners.
- Minimum dimensions 2' x 5', maximum 3' x 6'.
- Banners must be made by 4-H members.

## **DIVISION A - TABLE DISPLAYS**

Table Displays and Club Booths must be brought to the Farm Pavilion on Saturday August 3 from 10 AM to 2 PM.

- Exhibits must be on a standard card table, 34" x 34"
- Exhibitors MUST furnish their own card table and the table needs to be in good condition and legs must LOCK IN PLACE and will not buckle or fold if the table gets bumped.
- You may not use wall dividers
- Display topic must have one narrow main idea i.e. not Electricity but Circuit, not Horses but Bridles, not Entomology but Collecting Tools.
- Display topic must fit into one of the member's project areas.
- Displays are to be set up by the 4-H exhibitor, not by their leader or family member.
- Displays to be set up Saturday before fair, August 5<sup>th</sup> 10 AM to 3 PM. Displays must be set up and in place by this time or will be marked down by 1 ribbon placing.

## **DIVISION B - EDUCATIONAL CLUB BOOTHS**

**Table Displays and Club Booths must be brought to the Farm Pavilion on Saturday August 3 from 10 AM to 2 PM.**

- Please email the superintendent the size or estimated size of your club booth by July 25th
- All Club Booths must be set up by 4-H Club members, NOT by their leaders or their parents.
- Entries MUST be set up Saturday. Displays must be set up and in place by this time or will be marked down one ribbon placing.
- There will be a marked off space with your club's name on it, please stay within your club's designated area. If there is not a space with your club's name, please contact the Superintendent.
