Entries must be brought to the Peoples Bank Farm Pavilion on Thursday, August 1 between 3 pm and 7 pm. Please park outside Gate 1 and walk around the Farm Pavilion. Entries and ribbons should be picked up on the Sunday following the fair from 12 pm to 2 pm in the Farm Pavilion.

- Two late entries will be accepted at the time of entry drop off.
- Open to all kindergarten, first or second grade members enrolled in the Whatcom County 4-H program.
- Cloverbud 4-H members must enter all still life entries in this department. Any Cloverbud projects entered in the wrong Department will be moved.
- Cloverbud 4-H participation ribbons will be awarded. No premiums.

DIVISION A - CLOVERBUD STILL LIFE

Maximum 8 entries per Cloverbud member, no more than 3 entries per class. Cloverbud Still Life includes all project areas. It can include any article or display made or used as a part of your project. Exhibits entered in this division are not available for use in Division C "Show and Tell".

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places. Project can be taken home after judging. An adult must always remain with the Cloverbud.
