RABBIT AND CAVY GENERAL RULES:

- 4-H Exhibitors must show in Fitting and Showing receive premiums for type.**
- Entries must be owned by the exhibitor for at least 45 days prior to the fair. No substitutions are allowed.
- Exhibitors must be entered in a Rabbit or Cavy 4-H Project Area related to their entries.
- Limited to **three rabbits and two cavies** per exhibitor in 4-H. Additional rabbits and cavy meeting their breed standards can be entered in Open Class.
- 4-H Rabbits may not be cross entered in Open Class or FFA.
- All rabbits entered must be at least 10 weeks of age, except the fryer class.
- All rabbits exhibited must have an ear marking for identification purposes recorded on the entry tag.** The Lynden Junior Livestock Sale requires a specific tattoo. In non-market sale animals, the marking can be a tattoo or permanent marker. Include marking on registration.
- Rabbits will be inspected at time of entry and during the fair. Any rabbit found to be carrying an infectious disease or parasite will be removed from the building and the owner notified.
- Rabbits and Cavy will be fed, watered, cleaned, and cared for by the Superintendent and their clerks.**
- The management shall have the right to refuse entry and to remove from the Fair all diseased, unsightly, or dangerous animals and the Superintendent is expected to avail him/herself of this right.
- Same rabbit may be entered in type and fur classes. All rabbits entered in fur class must also be entered in type class.
- DOES WITH LITTERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Please include your rabbit or cavies color in the description box of entry form.

All Livestock Sale rabbits must be tattooed with the owner's initials, the current year, and one other number. For example, John Smith would be JS268. Any market rabbits not tattooed this way at weigh in will be tattooed by a member of the LJLS committee at that time. Weight and age are as of Tuesday of Fair. Exhibitors must have LJLS Quality Assurance Form in hand at weigh in. Rabbits will be moved to the correct class after being weighed. Do not enter the same rabbit in multiple classes.

CLASS NUMBER

1. Single Fryer – 3.5-5.5 pounds, recommended age 8-10 weeks, will move to roaster class if over 5.5 pounds
2. Single Roaster – 5.5-9 pounds, age 10 weeks to under 6 months
3. Single Stewer – 8-10 pounds, age over 6 months, cannot be sold in LJLS
