Adequate Body Condition – Minimum BCS of 4/9 – Henneke Scale

- 1-2: Severe Emaciation
- 3-4: Thin
- 5-6: Healthy

- 7-8: Overweight
- 9: Sever Obesity
- Feed and water should be available at the Fair at all times

Lameness/Prescription Drug Use

- Horses on any prescription meds, especially Bute, Banamine, Equioxx or Surpass SHOULD bring a letter of explanation from their Veterinarian.
- No horses with significant lameness, arthritis or chronic laminitis will be admitted.
