 The goal of the Veterinary Inspection is to minimize the potential for contagious and infectious diseases (including parasites). Examples of Infectious Disease and Parasites include: Erysipelas Evidence of Diarrhea Ring Worm High Fever Snout Health/Respiratory Evidence of Coughing No Visible External Parasite Burden (or related clinical signs):
