RULES

- Entries in Art and Photography must be either framed or suitable for hanging with binder clips.
- Framed entries must have secure hangers, no glue or tape hangers will be accepted.
- Entries with multiple pieces must be mounted or placed in a container suitable for display.
- All entries will be judged using the Danish System. This judging process compares each exhibit on its own merit against the recognized standard and awards as many firsts, seconds, etc. as merited.
- Best of Show winners will also receive the \$50 Dorothy Bennett Memorial award.

2. If entering a group or entire classroom project, register in Division 215. These items will be displayed by School, Teacher/Class, Student. Otherwise, register in the Division that best represents their grade.
