RULES

The quality desired in agriculture and horticultural products is the quality that brings the best financial return in the commercial market, and such exhibits must be at least equal in maturity as that state of ripeness required by the Food and Agricultural Code in order to be considered for award.

- "Mature" means having reached that stage of ripeness which will insure the completion of the ripening process to a degree which will insure palatability, after the removal of the product from the tree, plant or vine.
- "Overripe" means having an advance stage of maturity which causes the product to be undesirable for human consumption in a fresh state.

NOTE: Monstrosities will not be considered for premium awards.

- A. Each entry must include 3 fruits or 3 vegetables. Berries must be in a 3 oz. basket.
- B. Napa County Fair will furnish uniform containers for plate displays.
- C. Leafy vegetables may be received in a re-sealable plastic bag for freshness.

D. BUNCHES MUST BETIED.

E. Fruits and vegetables may be from cold storage from previous year's crop.
