Miscellaneous material can be used such as filler flowers or materials, foliage from other plants, etc. The arrangement and display of the container, materials, and flowers used are important elements judges consider. Design, creativity, technique, color choices, and condition of the flowers are evaluated when judging. Please treat your fresh exhibits before your arrival so that the entries will remain fresh as long as possible through the duration of the fair.

## Contest Requirements:

- 1 Contestants must provide everything for their exhibit except the table. Trees may be real or artificial. Tree and decorations should fit on a flat area not to exceed 30” deep x 24” wide x 48” high. You may place your lights and/or decorations on your tree at home or within the time limit we provide for set up. *Any store-bought pre-decorated trees or fiber optic or fiber glow trees will be disqualified.* Please provide an extension cord if using electric decor. Unlit candles only due to fire regulations. The Fair is not responsible for loss or breakage of items used for entries.
- 2 Tree decor theme is up to the entrant. Themes must be appropriate for audiences of all ages and submitted with registration.
- 3 Decorating will only be allowed during the designated time (see above.) Only the person whose name appears on the entry form is allowed in the exhibit area during set-up. No one may touch their own completed entry once the end time is reached or another exhibitor’s entry. Trees must be removed on Monday after the close of the fair during the Creative Arts pick-up times (see Creative Arts General Rules)
- 4 Fair management reserves the right to remove any items if deemed improper or hazardous. Although reasonable efforts will be undertaken to safeguard exhibitor’s property against loss, damage or theft, TNF will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or theft of exhibitors’ property. Every precaution will be taken in the handling and exhibiting of entries.

## Contest Requirements:

- Exhibitors will provide standard card table, not to exceed 36” diameter, round or square.
- Each display must consist of 1 or 2 place settings and a centerpiece. Themes are exhibitor’s choice and must be displayed along with menu on a minimum 5“x7” card. Place settings must be appropriate to menu and theme. Fresh flowers and greenery are allowed. Unlit candles only due to fire regulations.
- Entry set-up will only be allowed at the designated time (see above.) Only the person whose name appears on the entry form is allowed in the exhibit area during set-up. No one may touch their own completed entry, or another exhibitor’s entry, once the end time is reached. Table and decor must be removed on Monday after the close of the fair during the Creative Arts pick-up times (see Creative Arts General Rules)
- Fair management reserves the right to remove any items if they are deemed to be improper or hazardous. Although reasonable efforts will be undertaken to safeguard exhibitor’s property against loss, damage or theft, TSFA will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or theft of exhibitors’ property. Every precaution will be taken in the handling and exhibiting of entries.
