1. This show is open to any junior exhibitor, pre-school up to a senior who has not graduated high school. NOTE: Alabama bred and born champions will be selected from highest placing lambs in each class.
2. Lambs will be entered as: Black face cross; White face cross, Haired and Natural. Lambs subject to inspection at check in and adjustments made as needed.
3. **Ewes may be shown in the market show on Saturday with appropriate separate entry. Also, there is no separate showmanship with the ewe show. Showmanship is Ewe and Market lambs combined beginning at 12:00 noon with ewe and market lamb classes to follow.**
4. Ewes should be lambs born after December 1, 2023 and have their lamb milk teeth. Subject to inspection.
5. **Weigh in is Friday, November 1st from 4:30 pm to 9:00 pm. Late arrivals November 2nd from 8:00-9:00 am. Show begins at noon with showmanship, Jr. Breeding ewes then Market lambs.**
6. Entry fee is \$10.00 per head. Pen fee is \$5.00 per pen. Tack pens may be available as space allows. However, Pens may be assigned based on paid spots to facilitate clean out.
7. **Entry deadline is October 18, 2024. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE EXCEPTED.**
8. All lambs need to be clipped prior to arrival. All lambs must be removed from pens following the market show on Saturday.
9. Exhibitors are to enter the ring and show unassisted in all classes. The show committee will provide encouragement and assistance as needed. If help is needed it can only be verbal. Setting up and bracing is to be done by exhibitor of record unless they have more than one lamb in the same class.
10. Animals must be free of any contagious diseases or active fungus. All lambs are subject to screening. Any affected animals must be removed from the barns. All lambs must have appropriate scrapie ID tags.
11. Any exhibitor or owner in any way involved in showing a fraudulent entry of observed engaging in practices determined to affect animal welfare will automatically forfeit all premiums and be barred from future participation in this show.
12. All people attending any NPF show, excluding the exhibitor, **MUST** pay gate admission. Exhibitor will receive a free admission armband. This must be worn on your wrist at all times. Gate admission tickets are available when you register online. Ticket options are: 4-day Pass \$20 each or 1-day Pass for \$8.00 each. Deadline to purchase these admission tickets is Friday, October 18, 2024.
13. One (1) Ag Parking pass decal can be purchased for \$25.00 which including **one vehicle and trailer**. No showing off the trailer. After unloading, all vehicles and trailers must be moved promptly. Those with the Ag Parking Decal will be directed to their designated area. All others will have to park in the South Parking lot. All vehicles/trailers not parked correctly & left unattended will be towed. No showing off the trailer.
14. No sleeping in the barns and no pets allowed. PLEASE have a printed copy of entry receipt to resolve possible questions or mistakes. To avoid gate delay, purchase all required passes and tickets during entry process.

MARKET SHOW RULES

1. **Registration ONLINE only @ www.nationalpeanutfestival.com** *NEW* Market lambs will be divided into 4 divisions: Black face Cross - White face Cross - Haired - Natural. Committee can make adjustments as needed. Alabama bred and born awards will be given from highest placing ALBB lambs from each class.
2. Open to all youth (Pre-school through 12th grade). Exhibitor **MUST NOT** be graduated from High School.
3. **Weigh in is Friday, November 1st from 4:30 pm to 9:00 pm. Late arrivals November 2nd from 8:00-9:00 am. Show begins at noon with showmanship, Jr. Breeding ewes then Market lambs.** Entrants will be notified at weigh-in if the chairman anticipates a delay.
4. All entries should have their milk teeth and been born after December 1, 2023. This show counts for Alabama Bred & Born points.
5. Exhibitors will enter the ring and show the animal unassisted in all classes. The show committee will provide encouragement and assistance as needed.
6. Showmanship (7) divisions are listed below.
7. **Any exhibitor, or owner, in any way involved in showing a fraudulent entry will automatically forfeit all prize money won by himself or his farm and will be barred from future participation in this show.**
8. An entry fee of \$10.00 per head for market classes and no charge for showmanship. Pen fees are \$5.00 per pen. **NO TACK PENS!!** The deadline for registration forms and entry fees is October 18, 2024. No entries will be accepted after October 18, 2024. Any entries received after this date will be returned.
9. ALL lambs must be removed following the show to facilitate clean out.
10. **ALL LAMBS MUST BE SLICK SHORN PRIOR TO ARRIVAL. All lambs must pen in designated area.**
11. Any lamb showing signs for active club lamb fungus or other contagious diseases will be excused from participation.
12. All animals must be accompanied by a Veterinarian's Health Certificate and will be subject to a screening committee. **EAR TAG MUST MATCH HEALTH CERTIFICATE.**
13. **AFTER UNLOADING, ALL VEHICLES & TRAILERS MUST BE MOVED TO THE DESIGNATED AREA. THOSE PARKED INCORRECTLY & LEFT UNATTENDED WILL BE TOWED.**
