GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. <u>All entries must be pre-registered.</u> The deadline is Friday, October 20, 2023. Mail or drop off entry forms at: National Peanut Festival, 5622 Highway 231 South, Dothan, Alabama 36301.
- 2. Space requires the Festival to limit entries to **one person per class**.
- 3. Exhibits must be placed for judging and display between 4:00 and 7:00 PM, Thursday, October 26, 2023. Please bring your entries to the Premium Building on the Fairgrounds on Highway 231 South.
- 4. Entries must remain on display through during of the festival. NO EXCEPTIONS! Entries may be picked up from the NPF Premium Building on Monday, November 13th from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
- 5. All reasonable caution in handling and safeguarding of exhibits will be exercised, but the Festival cannot assume responsibility for any loss or damage incurred.
- 6. <u>1st Place winning entries may not be reentered at all.</u>
- 7. **Professionals are only allowed to enter in a class with a professional class.** Professionals are considered to be persons receiving all or part of their income from their craft, including teaching or instructing.
- 8. The Miscellaneous Division will accept <u>only items</u> that do not fit any other class.
- 9. Item must fit behind the fencing and sit on the bleachers.
- 10. <u>Wood, metal and leather must stick to strict size limits.</u>
- 11. NO KNIVES OR BLADES of any description may be entered.

PRIZES

- *1. Each class will be judged on the merits of the item. Judges will use their own discretion in awarding ribbons.
- 2. Rosette winners in Divisions 101-104 and 106-108 will compete for Best of Show Adult .*
- 3. Rosette winners in Divisions 109 111 will compete for **Best of Show Youth.***
- 4. Rosette winners from Professional classes will compete for **Best of Show Professionals.***
- 5. Division 105 Peanut Craft Grand Prize winner will also receive Best of Show Peanut Crafts.*
- 6. Premium checks will be given to each winner when the entry is picked up on Monday, November 13th. Checks must be picked up by exhibitor only. Any checks not picked up by 6:00 PM on Monday, November 13th will be mailed from the NPF office to the name and address given on the entry form. Please be sure to include all the information requested on the entry form, and make sure it is legible. Premium checks are issued based upon judges scoring sheets, not ribbon placement.
- 7. No exhibitor tickets will be given for entries.
