GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **All entries must be pre-registered.** The deadline is Friday, October 22, 2021. Mail entry forms to: National Peanut Festival, 5622 Highway 231 South, Dothan, Alabama 36301.
2. Space requires the Festival to limit entries to **one person per lot.**
3. **Exhibits must be placed for judging and display between 4:00 and 7:00 PM, Thursday, October 28, 2021.** Please bring your entries to the Premium Building on the Fairgrounds on Highway 231 South.
4. **Entries must remain on display through Sunday, November 14th. NO EXCEPTIONS!** Entries may be picked up from the NPF Premium Building on Monday, November 15th from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Any entry not picked up before 6:00 PM on Monday, November 15th will become the property of the National Peanut Festival.
5. Only judges and chairmen will be allowed in the building until 5:00 PM, Friday, November 5th. Winners will not be announced until the building opens at 5:00 PM.
6. All reasonable caution in handling and safeguarding of exhibits will be exercised, but the Festival cannot assume responsibility for any loss or damage incurred.
7. **No paintings, drawings, sketches or posters of any medium will be accepted in this department.**
8. 1st Place winning entries may not be reentered at all.
9. **Professionals are only allowed to enter in a class with a professional class.** Professionals are considered to be persons receiving all or part of their income from their craft, including teaching or instructing.
10. The Miscellaneous Division will accept only items that do not fit any other class.
11. **Item must fit behind the fencing and sit on the bleachers.**
12. **Wood, metal and leather must stick to strict size limits.**
13. **NO KNIVES OR BLADES of any description may be entered.**

PRIZES

- *1. **Each class will be judged on the merits of the item. Judges will use their own discretion in awarding ribbons.**
2. Rosette winners in Division 01 through 12 will compete for a silver tray for **Best of Show.***
3. Rosette winners in Division 13 – 15 will compete for **Best of Youth.***
4. Rosette winners from Professional classes will compete **Best of Professionals.***
5. Premium checks will be given to each winner when the entry is picked up on Monday, November 15th. Checks must be picked up by exhibitor only. Any checks not picked up by 6:00 PM on Monday, November 15th will be mailed from the NPF office to the name and address given on the entry form. Please be sure to include all the information requested on the entry form, and make sure it is legible. **Premium checks are issued based upon judges scoring sheets, not ribbon placement.**
6. No exhibitor tickets will be given for entries.
