#### **General Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Applications must be in no later than Thursday, October 26, 2023. Mail your entry to National Peanut Festival, 5622 US Hwy. 231 South, Dothan, Alabama 36301.
- 2. All entries must be placed between **3:00 PM and 6:00 PM**, Wednesday, November 1st. *PLEASE NOTE:* Step one- Drop off entry at Premium Building; Step two- move vehicle to north parking lot Alfa entrance; Step three- return to Premium Building to complete paper work/check –in. No entries will be accepted any other time. Contact Crystal Ellenburg if there is a problem or question, 790-5192.
- 3. Plants must remain on display thru the duration of the festival and CANNOT be picked up without a claim ticket. Entries and premium checks may be picked up on Monday, November 13th from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Entries not picked up by 6:00 PM on Monday, November 14th will become the property of the National Peanut Festival. Please be sure to include all the information requested on the entry form, and make sure it is legible. Premium checks are issued based upon judges scoring sheets, not ribbon placement.
- 4. Only one entry per person per <u>CLASS</u>. Each entry is to be picked up by the person that won the prize whether it is a ribbon, money or a tray. (Example: Fern Division has 4 classes, that means you can enter a Boston Type fern, a Asparagus Type fern, a Maidenhair fern and 1 any other type. If you are unsure, please contact one of above committee members and we will be glad to assist you with this understanding.)
- 5. The Festival will exercise every possible means of care, but <u>cannot</u> be responsible for loss or damage.
- 6. Entry forms must be completed with class and lot indicated. All specimens must be named, giving genus and species. Please note the Dept. Code for Horticulture is HOR. The division and class numbers are listed below. There may not be a class for each division, if not leave this blank on the entry form.
- 7. Show is judged by state certified judges.
- 8. A 1<sup>st</sup> Place overall and/or 2<sup>nd</sup> Place overall winner is not eligible the following year to enter the <u>same</u> <u>plant</u>.
- 9. Competition is open to amateur gardeners whether members of a Garden Club or not.
- 10. The committee may reclassify any entry at their discretion.
- 11. In Cut Flower Division containers are furnished. No artificial coloring. Cut specimens should not have any foliage <u>below</u> the water line.
- 12. All horticulture specimens must be fresh plant materials grown by exhibitors. Container grown plants must have been in exhibitor's possession at least 90 days, except for multiple plantings, which must have been in exhibitor's possession at least six weeks.
- 13. Each division must have three or more entries to be judged.

- 14. No professional or commercial growers are allowed to exhibit.
- 15. No plant over 150 lbs. will be accepted, unless pre-approved by the Committee Chairman (due to the inability to move the plant around for category placement).

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons will be awarded in each class. There will be one rosette winner per division. All rosette winners will compete for 1<sup>st</sup> Place Overall and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Overall.

## **Judging Criteria**

- 1. Plant Appearance
  - a. Overall appearance.
  - b. Uniform shape-indicating good rotation.
  - c. Clean pot and clean leaves. (No Leaf Shine)
  - d. Plant centered in pot.
  - e. Pot needs to compliment plant. (Plant is being judged not pot)
  - f. No freshly dug or repotted plants.
  - g. No more than one plant in pot unless it is a dish garden.
  - h. Healthy color and free from scale and other diseases.
  - i. Plants should be neatly groomed.
- 2. Plant Rarity
- 3. Difficulty in Growing Plant
- 4. Size and Age of Plant

This list is to help you understand the judging of your plant. The judges can disqualify <u>any</u> plant not meeting the judging criteria!!!
