JUNIOR HEIFER AND FEEDER STEER SHOW

Saturday, November 1, 2025 at 10 am

This is a BLOW and GO Show, NO FIT show. Animals should be shown clean and dry.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entry fee is \$10.00 per animal, per show. All registrations and entry payment **must** be completed **ONLINE @ nationalpeanutfestival.com**. Registration deadline is **Friday, October 17, 2025. NO EXCEPTIONS!** ALL people attending any National Peanut Festival show, excluding exhibitor, **MUST pay gate admission. Exhibitor will receive a free admission armband.** Gate admission tickets are available for: 4-day Pass \$20 each or 1-day Pass for \$8.00 each. One (1) Ag Parking pass can be purchased for \$25.00 which includes vehicle and trailer. Deadline for all ticket purchases is Friday, October 17, 2025. Please Note: No pen/stall fees for cattle shows.

2. Show will be Saturday, November 1, 2025. Showmanship begins at 9:00 am. The Junior Heifer Show will follow and the Steer Show will be last. All animals are shown at the owner's risk.
3. Any exhibitor, or owner, in any way involved in showing a fraudulent entry will automatically forfeit all prize money won by himself or his farm and will be barred from future participation in this show.
4. Competition is open to bona-fide 4-H, FFA or FCCLA members. Steer exhibitors must not have graduated from high school. Heifer exhibitors may not be more than one year out of high school or have completed the GED.
5. Commercial Heifers will be weighed and shown by weight. Feeder Steers will be divided into equal weight groups depending on total head. Steers should be ones to be shown in Spring shows.
6. All out of state cattle must have an updated health certificate and will be checked at check-in.
7. Calf must be owned by the exhibitor to be eligible for showmanship. All exhibitors MUST register for Showmanship Class to be eligible to participate for showmanship.
8. The barn will open at 10 AM Friday, Oct. 31st. Check-in for Jr. Heifer/Feeder Steer entries will begin at 3:00 PM, Fri., Oct. 31st, 2025 and must be in place by 6:00 PM. Trailers are NOT to be unloaded until barn assignment has been made. ONCE YOUR TRAILER IS UNLOADED, IT MUST BE MOVED IMMEDIATELY TO THE DESIGNATED AREA. Any trailer outside this area, left unattended, will be towed. NO vehicles will be permitted on the midway in front of the livestock barns.
- 9: Exhibitors MUST remain in the show ring until the Judge dismisses the class.
10. Bedding will be furnished. However, any additional bedding required for Junior Heifer and Feeder Steer Show will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
11. Due to Health Department regulations, all exhibitors will be required to place manure and bedding in designated locations. Failure to comply with this rule will result in withholding of premium money. Stalls need to be kept clean and neat at all times.
12. Breed shows shall consist of 2 or more exhibitors and 5 or more head, with registration papers. NPF will review all entries after the Oct. 17th deadline and reserves the right to make changes, based on the number of entries, to uphold the breed show rules. No more than two entries per lot, per exhibitor is allowed.

*The National Peanut Festival Association reserves the right to make and past rule changes as needed.
