



2022 POSTER CONTEST RULES

1. Poster contest will be open to children in the **third, fourth and fifth grades**. Please bring your entry to your school by October 21st, 2022. A first and second place poster will be chosen from each grade level. The winning posters will be taken to the Board of Education in your district. The winning entries will be picked up and place at the National Peanut Festival.
2. Posters must be 14 inches by 22 inches, which is one-half vertical sheet of poster board. **FULL SIZE POSTERS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.** We do not have sufficient space for displaying full size posters.
3. Any type of medium (chalk, paint, crayons, pencils, charcoal, felt markers or any combination) may be used.
4. The theme of the poster must be: **“Wiregrass Roots and Cowboy Boots”**.
5. Posters may be picked up at the fairgrounds on Monday, November 14th between the hours of 3:00 PM and 6:00 PM. Posters not picked up by 6:00 PM on Monday, November 14th will be taken to the Peanut Festival office. Posters will be destroyed after two weeks. **We cannot be responsible for lost posters.**

6. On the front of each poster, in the lower right hand corner, must be the following information:

NAME, GRADE AND NAME OF SCHOOL

Posters without this information on it will be disqualified.

7. There will be three winners selected from each grade level:

1st Place \$20.00
2nd Place \$15.00
3rd Place \$10.00
