NPF: GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. A Flock Testing Monitoring Report (testing dated within 30 days of the show) or proof of NPIP is required. Alabama Department of Agriculture & Industries state testing for Pullorum-Typhoid and Avian Influenza and will be done at no charge by poultry inspectors at coop-in on November 10, 2021. Chick Chain birds will only require testing for Avian Influenza. This report (or exhibitor provided NPIP documentation) will be provided by poultry inspectors to show organizers as the birds are checked in, and will be kept with show registration.
2. All entries are subject to a health check. Any bird appearing sick (i.e. cough, runny mucus from nostrils, etc.) or infested with parasites, dirty plumage, overgrown spurs, fowl pox, etc., will not be allowed to participate in the show and must be removed from the fairgrounds.
3. **Exhibitors must bring their own feed and will arrange for their birds to be cared for on a DAILY basis during the term of the exhibit.** This includes feeding, watering and cleaning cages. This supports health and safety for the birds by limiting exhibitors from accessing others’ cages. Exhibitors must also provide feeders and waterers – those secured to cages instead of free-standing are best because they are not easily spilled.
4. Cages. Keep in mind that there is no heat or air conditioning in the poultry exhibit area. Cages are generally placed on table tops. NPF 4-H/FFA/Open Show exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own cages, which provides an opportunity to showcase birds in home-made or designed cages. **If your cage is a designer cage, or freestanding, or in excess of 36”L x 30”W x 30”H, or weighs more than 15 pounds, or needs electricity provided, please contact Sheila Andreasen to pre-approve your cage.** Cages not pre-approved may not be allowed. Some show-owned cages may be provided upon request; however, there are only a limited number of cages and are provided first come first served. Chick Chain participants will be provided cages for Chick Chain Show birds.
5. Your bird area must be clean (inside/underneath/around) at all times, including coop out time. **If individual areas are not reasonably clean, premiums may be forfeited.** Please plan accordingly.

6. **The deadline for registration is October 15, 2021.**

- a. NPF 4-H/FFA/Open Shows: Entry fee is \$5.00 per bird and is non-refundable (maximum of 4 birds).
 - o Register by completing the Poultry Show Registration Form and NPF Ag Fees Payment Form; the forms may be mailed or hand-delivered to the NPF office. If you are NPIP certified, then you must include proof of NPIP with your registration and fees.
- b. Chick Chain Show: There is no fee for Chick Chain birds.
 - o Register by completing the Poultry Show Registration Form and NPF Ag Fees Payment Form (see Chick Chain below).

- 7. **AG Parking Decals and Gate Passes: All participants for the NPF 4-H/FFA/Open/Chick Chain Shows** - Ag Parking Decals and Gate Passes should be purchased by completing the NPF Ag Fees Payment Form. The decals and passes will get you in the gate with close parking to the barn.
- 8. A maximum of 4 birds per exhibitor is allowed for NPF 4-H/FFA/Open Shows; 2 birds (pullets of the same breed) are required for 4-H Chick Chain participants.
- 9. Any exhibitor, or owner, in any way involved in showing a fraudulent entry will automatically forfeit all prize money and may be barred from future participation in this show.
- 10. All exhibitors (including Chick Chain) will check in birds between 5pm and 8pm on Wednesday, November 10, 2021 and check them out between 8am and 2pm on Sunday, November 14, 2021. Chick Chain birds are the exception (see details below). No NPF 4-H/FFA or Open Show birds should be checked out prior to the coop-out date.
- 11. The shows will be located in the Winn-Dixie Ag Complex barn; all shows are open to the public.
- 12. The National Peanut Festival and show organizers reserve the right to substitute or add judges. The judges' decisions are final. Rules are subject to be amended.
- 13. Premium checks for prize money will be issued and mailed from the National Peanut Festival office after the close of the festival. Chick Chain Show checks will be mailed separately. Please include your complete mailing address when you register. Winners may also be required to submit a W-9 before prize money can be awarded.
- 14. The National Peanut Festival and show organizers will not be responsible for damage, loss or health risk to birds, cages, materials or equipment.

4-H & FFA YOUTH POULTRY SHOW

This show is open to bona fide active members of a chartered 4-H club or FFA chapter in AL, GA or FL. To be eligible for competition at events held between August 1, 2021 and July 31, 2022, youth must be at least 9 years old prior to January 1, 2022.

CLASSES: There are 5 classes. The poultry committee reserves the right to change the classification of an entry in order to better place the bird in the most appropriate class. Crossbreeds and commercial birds may be included. The classes:

- 1) Production Male – i.e. Rhode Island Reds, Barred Plymouth Rocks, Turken, etc.
- 2) Production Female – i.e. Rhode Island Reds, Barred Plymouth Rocks, Turken, etc.
- 3) Fancy – i.e. Silkies, Polish, Frizzles, Yokohama, Silver Phoenix, Ayam Cemani, etc.
- 4) Bantam – i.e. Rhode Island Reds, Cochins, Sebrights, Seramas, Old English Game, d’Uccles, etc.
- 5) Other – i.e. Quail, Ducks, Geese, Turkeys, Guineas, Pheasants, etc.

4-H/FFA SHOW AWARDS & PREMIUMS

The birds will be judged Thursday, November 11, 2021. Participants are not required to be present while the birds are being judged. All awards will be given out following the Showmanship program, which begins at 6pm on Thursday, November 11, 2021. Premium amounts below are based on entries and may be adjusted accordingly. Premium checks will be issued and mailed from the NPF office after the close of the festival. Awards and premiums are as follows:

4-H/FFA SHOWMANSHIP

Open to 4-H/FFA Participants only. Participants must be prepared to answer basic questions regarding the breed, variety and care of their bird(s). General poultry related questions may also be asked by the judges. Showmanship will be scored based on each participant’s personal appearance, knowledge and ability to handle the bird(s). For study and practice suggestions, contact your 4-H Agent or local county Extension office.

4-H SHOWMANSHIP AWARDS

First place in each age division receives a trophy, rosette, and \$25. Second through fifth places receive a ribbon. See above.

4-H SHOW CAGE DECORATING CONTEST

1st through 5th places will receive a Rosette
6th through 10th places will receive a ribbon
Keeping with the NPF’s theme is suggested.

4-H EDUCATIONAL EXHIBITS

1st through 5th places will receive a Rosette
6th through 10th places will receive a ribbon

We encourage youth to set up tri-boards and other poultry related educational exhibits (including portfolios/record books) based on projects they’ve worked on or are interested in....including poultry husbandry, incubation projects, egg displays, Chick Chain, Scarechicken, etc. Educational exhibit tables are available for these projects.

4-H JERRY WAYNE ABNER SPIRIT AWARD

Jerry Wayne Abner was Mr. 4-H in life. A self-taught chicken whisperer, he loved sharing his wit and knowledge with 4-H’ers as well as kids and adults of all ages. This award has been created in Mr. Jerry’s honor and is based on character, enthusiasm, leadership and community service. The spirit award recognizes a 4-H’er who is participating in this year’s NPF 4-H/FFA or Chick Chain poultry show, with entered birds as well as a portfolio/record book and an additional educational exhibit. DESIGNER CAGE CONTEST (OPEN TO ALL PARTICIPANTS, INCLUDING THOSE IN THE OPEN SHOW)

This contest is to showcase design, woodworking and construction skills. A great way to show off cages made at home. NOTE: If your cage is not freestanding, you must bring your own table to support the cage. You must also indicate if electricity is required. **Contact Sheila Andreasen to pre-approve your cage.** Cages not pre-approved may not be allowed.

The Open Show is judged completely separate from the 4-H/FFA Youth Show. Birds are judged only; there is no showmanship component to this show. The five classes are listed below. The poultry committee reserves the right to change the classification of an entry in order to better place the bird in the most appropriate class. Crossbreeds and commercial birds may be included. Birds will be judged Thursday, November 11, 2021. Participants are not required to be present during judging.

4-H CHICK CHAIN SHOW & AUCTION

The 4-H Chick Chain Show & Auction is for active 4-H participants only, who are registered in the Chick Chain project. Participating 4-H'ers received 10 female chicks (pullets) on June 18, 2021. By October 15, 2021, those youth entering the Chick Chain Show & Auction, will need to register two pullets of the same breed in order to enter the event at the National Peanut Festival (see page 2 about registration and fees). Breeds accepted via registration will be from the Chick Chain pullet project which includes the following breeds: Buff Orpington, Dominique, Easter Egger, and Rhode Island Red.

How to Register for the Chick Chain Show & Auction

1. Contact your county's 4-H Agent to let them know you are registering for the Chick Chain Show & Auction.
2. Complete the **NPF Poultry Show Registration Form**. (Note: for your two Chick Chain birds, you **do not** send a \$5 per bird registration payment to NPF). Make sure you indicate that Bird #1 and Bird #2 are "Chick Chain" birds, and then record the breed you are entering. For instance, if you are entering Rhode Island Reds, then you will write:

3. To purchase Ag Gate Decals and Gate Passes, you need to complete the **NPF Ag Fees Payment Form**. The decal and pass will get you in the Ag Gate so you can park close to the barn. You will need to mail or hand-deliver this form with payment to the NPF office, so they receive no later than October 15, 2021.

The Chick Chain Show & Auction

The 4-H Chick Chain Show birds will be judged separately from NPF 4-H/FFA Poultry Show birds. The 4-H Chick Chain Show will be Friday, November 12, 2021 at 6pm. The awards program will follow the show, and the auction follows the awards program. Please note that while the 4-H Chick Chain Show is Friday, November 12, 2021, the NPF 4-H/FFA Poultry Show will be Thursday, November 11, 2021. 4-H Chick Chain participants may participate in both shows, but the same individual birds used for Chick Chain cannot be used in the NPF show. When you check-in, you will be directed to take your 4-H Chick Chain Show birds to a special area, because they will not be mixed in with the NPF Show birds. Immediately following the conclusion of the Chick Chain Show & Auction, the Chick Chain Show birds should be removed from the fairgrounds (i.e., checked-out by auction winners). All other birds (those in the 4-H/FFA/Open Show), must remain until Sunday. Contact a committee member if you have any questions.
