

Preserved Foods

RULES:

- Exhibits shall be in standard clear jars (No color) unless otherwise specified
- Two identical jars must be included at the time entry is received. One jar is for judges to taste & the second jar is for display (The tasting jar will be discarded)
- Exhibitor must provide a 1" x 2" label for the jar, stating the product name, full canning date, and method used (e.g., WB for water bath, PC for pressure canner).
 Steam-canned or open items are not permitted. The exhibitor's name MUST not be on the label.
- Due to food safety issues, we reserve the right to refuse entries that do not comply by the above rules or are not properly sealed
