MARKET SWINE

Entry Forms Due By: Friday, June 12 by 4 pm

Receiving: Monday, August 10 until 9 pm

Official Weigh-in: Monday, August 10 from 7 pm - 9 pm

Non-show animal MUST be removed from the Fairgrounds by 8 pm Tuesday, August 11.

Judging: Thursday, August 13 at 8 am

Entry Fee: \$25 per entry

Rules: Open to Nevada County youth only.

- Exhibitors can show and sell only one market animal.
- Exhibitor may not have sold a market animal at any other county fair this year.
- Market-ready and not-market-ready classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes made in the Federal grading. See page 82 for full market-ready and non-market ready descriptions.
- Any market hog weighing over 280 pounds will not be "sifted" from the livestock auction, but will not be paid over 280 pounds.
- All market swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for 60 days prior to the opening day of the Fair.
- Limit the grooming and fitting of all animals to the most natural methods. See local rules on page 82 for more information.

NEVADA COUNTY BRED & FED

Entry Fee: \$10 per entry

Rules: *To enter this division, a market entry must be submitted.*

- Market Swine must have been bred within Nevada County and fed by an FFA, 4-H/Grange or Independent exhibitor to qualify.
- Only Market Swine shown in a market class and eligible for the Junior Livestock Auction qualify.
- Class breaks, if necessary, will be determined by the Livestock Superintendent and Fair Management.
- Copy of Bill of Sale must be included at time of entry and must verify the animal was bred in Nevada County. A letter stating it was bred and home-raised by the exhibitor is also acceptable.
- At judge's discretion, winner(s) may be selected without having all animals return to the show ring.

Entry Forms Due By: Monday, July 13 by 4 pm

Receiving: Monday, August 10 until 9 pm

Judging: Thursday, August 13, after Market Swine Show

Release: Sunday, August 16 at 8 pm

Entry Fee: \$10 per entry per class

Rules: Open to Nevada County youth only.

- Two animals per class per exhibitor.
- Registered and Grade Breeding Hog must upload to Cognito account a photo of "Bill of Sale", or a letter documenting that the animal(s) were home-raised and a front profile picture of animals face clearly showing ear tags and/or ear notches.
- Exhibitor must submit a ear-notching form online at time of entry.
- Swine can only be washed between 6 am and 9:30 am.
- A minimum of three (3) animals must be entered/ shown in each division or all animals may be combined into one division and/or class.
- If entries exceed barn capacity, management may limit exhibitors to two animals per divisions 706 & 707.
