NEW MEXICO STATE FAIR HORSESHOE PITCHING TOURNAMENT WINNERS ANNOUNCED

ALBUQUERQUE—September 22, 2015—The first ever New Mexico State Fair Horseshoe Tournament took place at this year's New Mexico State Fair and it was a huge success, with participants and spectators alike having a fantastic time in the Shoes 'n' Brews Bar. The competition was sponsored by Disc-It.

Qualifying took place during the first seven days of the fair. Each team was made up of 2 people and the top 50 teams advanced to a Single Elimination Tournament held on the last Saturday of the fair, September 19, where the list was narrowed to the top 25 teams.
