## **Special Rules**

- Egg Art is open to any person creating decorative eggs, who <u>does not</u> derive a livelihood from their creations.
- 2. All youths 17 and under may enter and will be judged separately from adults.
- 3. Quality is emphasized and entries will be judged in craftsmanship, originality, creativity and beauty.

- 4. Entries entered must be composed of real eggs: ostrich, rhea, emu, goose, etc. and completed since the previous New Mexico State Fair.
- 5. Entries must be created by the exhibitor.
- Due to limited display area, only a limited number of entries may be accepted for display.
- 7. Exhibitor's name on any entry must be concealed.
- Classification and acceptance of entries will be at the discretion of the officials. Protective cases are strongly advised.
- 9. Precautions are taken for the safety of all entries, but in no case, will the New Mexico State Fair, the state of New Mexico, employees, contractors or volunteers be held liable for the loss or damages to any entry while in the Fair's possession. Participants are encouraged to carry their own insurance.
- 10. Participant recognizes that marketing of the Fair and its grounds requires use of photography and video. Participant hereby expressly grants to the Fair the irrevocable, assignable right and license to take, use and publish participant images and work without the need for any other approval. Images and work will not be used for profit.
- 11. Participants are responsible for picking up their own work or provide written authorization for pick-up by another individual.
- <u>NEW:</u> Work must be picked up Tuesday, September 17, 2024 from 9:00am – 4:00pm. Any work remaining on the Fairgrounds after this date will be considered abandoned and shall become the property of the NM State Fair to be disposed of at its discretion.

## Egg Art Sections 420 – 421

#### Section 420: Adult, 18 years and over

#### Class 1-9

- 1. Beaded: Where beading of the shell is worked into the design.
- 2. Diorama: One or more openings, no hinges
- 3. Hand Painted: Oils, acrylics, etc., at least one-half of shell must be painted.
- 4. Jeweled: Any style of egg where jewelry is worked into the design.
- 5. Jewelry: Any jewelry made from egg.
- 6. Jewelry Box: Must open as to hold jewelry.
- 7. Mechanical: Electrical outlets not available.
- 8. Miniatures: 3" & under, any egg smaller than a hen egg.
- 9. Miscellaneous: Any other not listed above.

### Section 421: Youth, 17 years & under

#### Class10-18

- Beaded: Where beading of the shell is worked into the design.
- 11. Diorama: One or more openings, no hinges
- 12. Hand Painted: Oils, acrylics, etc., at least one-half of shell must be painted.
- Jeweled: Any style of egg where jewelry is worked into the design.
- 14. Jewelry: Any jewelry made from egg.
- 15. Jewelry Box: Must open as to hold jewelry.
- 16. Mechanical: Electrical outlets not available.
- 17. Miniatures: 3" & under, any egg smaller than a hen egg.
- 18. Miscellaneous: Any other not listed above.
