- Entries must be one of a kind, multiple production items not allowed.

- Pieces must be ready for display, with all wires, hooks and chains attached appropriately.
- Judges may reject or reclassify entries. Decisions of the judges are final.

Participants are encouraged to carry their own insurance.

Participant hereby expressly grants to the Fair the irrevocable, assignable right and license to take, use and publish participant images and work without the need for any other approval. Images and work will not be used for profit.
- Participants are responsible for picking up their own work or provide written authorization for pick-up by another individual.
- 13. NEW: Work must be picked up Tuesday, September 17, 2024 from 9:00am 4:00pm. Any work remaining on the Fairgrounds after this date will be considered abandoned and shall become the property of the NM State Fair to be disposed of at its discretion
