1. Entries:

The entry deadline is midnight August 1st. Entries will only be accepted online through the New Mexico State Fair website. The entry fee is \$20.00 per heifer. The entry fee for the Showmanship Class is \$5.00. **Late Entry Fee:** Late Entries will be accepted until August 10th of the current year with a late fee of \$10.00 per animal. **ALL ENTRIES WILL BE ENTERED & PAID ONLINE**

2. Supplies:

Bedding will not be provided by the New Mexico State Fair.

3. Arrival/Departure:

Jr. Dairy Cattle entries must be on grounds by 5:00pm Monday, September 9, 2024 and will depart two (2) hours after the conclusion of the show.

Special Rules - Breeding

See Junior Division General Livestock Rules

1. Animals shown in this department must have been continuously owned or leased by the exhibitor not less than 60 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the Fair. Individual

animals shown in all group classes must have been entered and shown in one of the classes for single animals.

- 2. A copy of registration and lease must be turned in at check-in.
- 3. No animal can be entered or exhibited unless the same has been recorded in the recognized Book of Records for the respective breeds, and exhibitors must produce certificates of registry at the request of the Superintendent in charge anytime during the Fair.
- 4. Exhibitors may wear white shirts and blue jeans or dairy colors while in the show ring.
- 5. Parking Permits and Exhibitors Pass: Please see Schedule of Fees for Junior Livestock.
